SECTION I - SAFETY

The Applicant agrees to provide adequate traffic and crowd control, emergency medical services and any other items, at the Applicant's expense, required by Lee County to protect the health, safety and welfare of the public. Lee County shall have the power to review the proposal and require, as necessary, detailed plans, diagrams, and explanations to clearly outline to Lee County, exactly what the Applicant is proposing.

SECTION II - INSURANCE

The Applicant, at its sole expense, agrees to procure and maintain in force during the entire term of the application, liability insurance in the amounts determined by Lee County Risk Management to protect against damages or other claims arising from use of County property by the applicant or its guests. Other limits may also be established by Lee County Risk Management for events which will be serving or consuming alcoholic beverages at approved County property. The insurance policy must also include coverage for Applicant's contingent liability on damages, claims or losses. "Lee County Board of County Commissioners" must be named as "additional insured" on the Certificate of Insurance, and the Certificate must be delivered to Lee County prior to Applicant's use of the property. The Insurance may not be canceled during the term of the event, if this occurs, the County has the right to revoke approvals related to use of the County property for the event, without recourse by the applicant.

SECTION III - INDEMNIFICATION

The Applicant agrees to indemnify, release and save harmless Lee County against any and all claims, costs, demands, damages, judgments or injuries of any nature arising from the conduct or management of, or from any work or thing whatsoever done in or about said Lee County property or any building or structure appurtenant thereto or equipment thereof during the term of this Permit, or arising during such term from any act of negligence of the Applicant, Applicant's agents, contractors, or employees, or arising from any accident, injury, or damage whatsoever, however caused, to any person or persons, or to any property of any person, persons, corporation or corporations, occurring during the term of this agreement on, in, or about said Lee County property, and from and against all costs, attorney's fees, expenses and liabilities occurring in connection with any such claim or any action or proceeding brought thereon.

For film permit applicants: The permittee shall have on-site a responsible representative empowered with authority over the filming director, filming crews, participants and filming operation. Permittee shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the county, its officers, agents and employees from and against all claims, suits, actions, damages, liabilities, expenditures or causes of action of any kind arising out of or occurring during the activities of the permittee, and resulting or occurring from any negligent act, omission or error of permittee, resulting in or relating to injuries to body, life, limb or property sustained in, about or upon the permitted premises or improvement thereto, or arising from the use of the premises.

SECTION IV - DELIVERY, ACCEPTANCE AND SURRENDER OF PREMISES

The Applicant agrees to accept the County property on possession as being in a satisfactory state of repair and in sanitary condition.

The Applicant must surrender the premises to Lee County in the same condition as when Applicant takes possession, allowing for reasonable use and wear, and damage by acts of God. Applicant agrees to remove all business signs or symbols placed on the premises by the Applicant before redelivery of the premises to Lee County, and restore the premises to the condition in which it existed before their placement. Any signs and markings created or used in connection with this event must be temporary and removable; painting roadways, trees or any other fixed object is strictly prohibited. Applicant agrees to clear the Lee County property of litter at the close of the event.

SECTION V - AGREEMENT

The Applicant agrees that Lee County can, at its sole discretion, terminate and cancel its permit to use Lee County property at any time without prejudice. Applicant further agrees to waive, release, save and hold harmless Lee County from any and all claims, demands or cause of actions based upon Lee County's cancellation or termination of said permit.

The Applicant agrees that the Lee County permit does not provide Applicant with any property rights in the County property in question or in the permit itself.

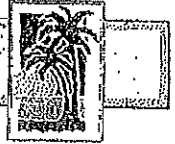

Project Description: Special Event – 4th of July Celebration

This project has received a fire review from the Lehigh Acres Fire Control and Rescue District to determine compliance with the Florida Fire Prevention Code, as required within Florida Statutes 553.79(2). This fire review is limited to the documents provided to the fire district by the applicant. The following stipulations for fire review approval of the application are as follows:

STIPULATIONS

The following comments are provided based upon sheet/page 7 of the Lee County Event Application that was presented for fire review of the proposed event. The event has estimated a crowd size of 1000 persons or more.

1. This event shall maintain at least one (1) crowd manager for every 250 persons associated with the event. At least one (1) crowd manager supervisor shall be present where more than one (1) crowd manager is required. This event shall have at least four (1000 person crowd) at all times with additional crowd managers being provided where the size of the crowd increases above 1000 persons. NFPA 101-12.7.6. Persons designated and/or serving as a crowd manager shall meet the qualifications for a crowd manager as found within NFPA 101-12.7.6. Crowd managers shall maintain appropriate communication equipment for to communicate with other staff and 911. They must also maintain adequate illumination devices on their person at all times to aid in crowd control.
2. Food truck/trailers shall be inspected and approved by the fire district not later than Friday, July 1, 2022. Mobile food vendors inspected and approved by the fire district six months or less are not required to be reinspected unless they have

undergone changes to their mobile unit/equipment. Mobile food vendors shall comply with the requirements of NFPA 1-50.

3. Event application notes the time of the event from 5 PM until 10 PM. As Lee County EMS has waived comments to Lehigh Acres for EMS protection, and as the event size is noted at 1000 or more persons, a Lehigh Acres ambulance/rescue shall be provided at the event from 5 PM until 10 PM. Based upon Lehigh Acres Fire Control and Rescue District resolution 22-03-01 – Exhibit A, Section G.4 and G.14, fire district staff and an ALS ambulance rate of \$141.76 per hour for the five (5) hour scheduled period shall be paid to the district to staff an ambulance for this event. Total fee for the ambulance and crew is \$708.80 and must be paid prior Friday, July 1, 2022 to the fire district. The ambulance will serve as the first aid crew for this event and will need to be provided with a point to stage the ambulance within the event. An access road of at least 20 feet in clear width shall be maintained and open for access of fire, police, and other emergency vehicles to within 200 feet of all buildings.
4. This event will start or lead to a fireworks display for which permit TMP2022-00161 is being reviewed. No unauthorized person(s) are allowed within the exclusion zone while fireworks are on site and during the launching of the fireworks. This area will need to be provided with barricades to prevent access. Fire truck access must be provided in the event of an emergency.
5. A 2A:10B:C rated fire extinguisher shall be available to all areas of the event with a maximum travel distance of 75 feet. A 2A:10B:C fire extinguisher shall be within 20 feet of food cooking operations. Each mobile food vendor should have their own equipment.
6. Fireworks that leave the ground are not permitted within the special event, except under the supervision and approval of TMP2022-00161 – within the designated discharge zone.
7. A Lehigh Acres Fire Control and Rescue District fire engine and/or brush truck is being assigned to this event at the time the fireworks are scheduled to be discharged. The event manager shall call the on-duty Battalion Chief (239-896-0140) a minimum of 2 hours before the scheduled fireworks to verify time for the discharge of the fireworks and placement of the fire suppression unit(s) for this event. TMP 2022-00161 notes fireworks at 9 PM.
8. A fire inspection will be required for both special event permits. The inspection for the band stage, mobile food vendor placement, tents, access (etcetera) for the main event must have all elements ready for inspection by 4 PM, the day of the event. The inspection for the fireworks discharge must be ready for inspection no later than 7:30 PM, the day of the event, to ensure an adequate amount of daylight is available to safely conduct the fire inspection. This inspection will not be postponed to a later time.

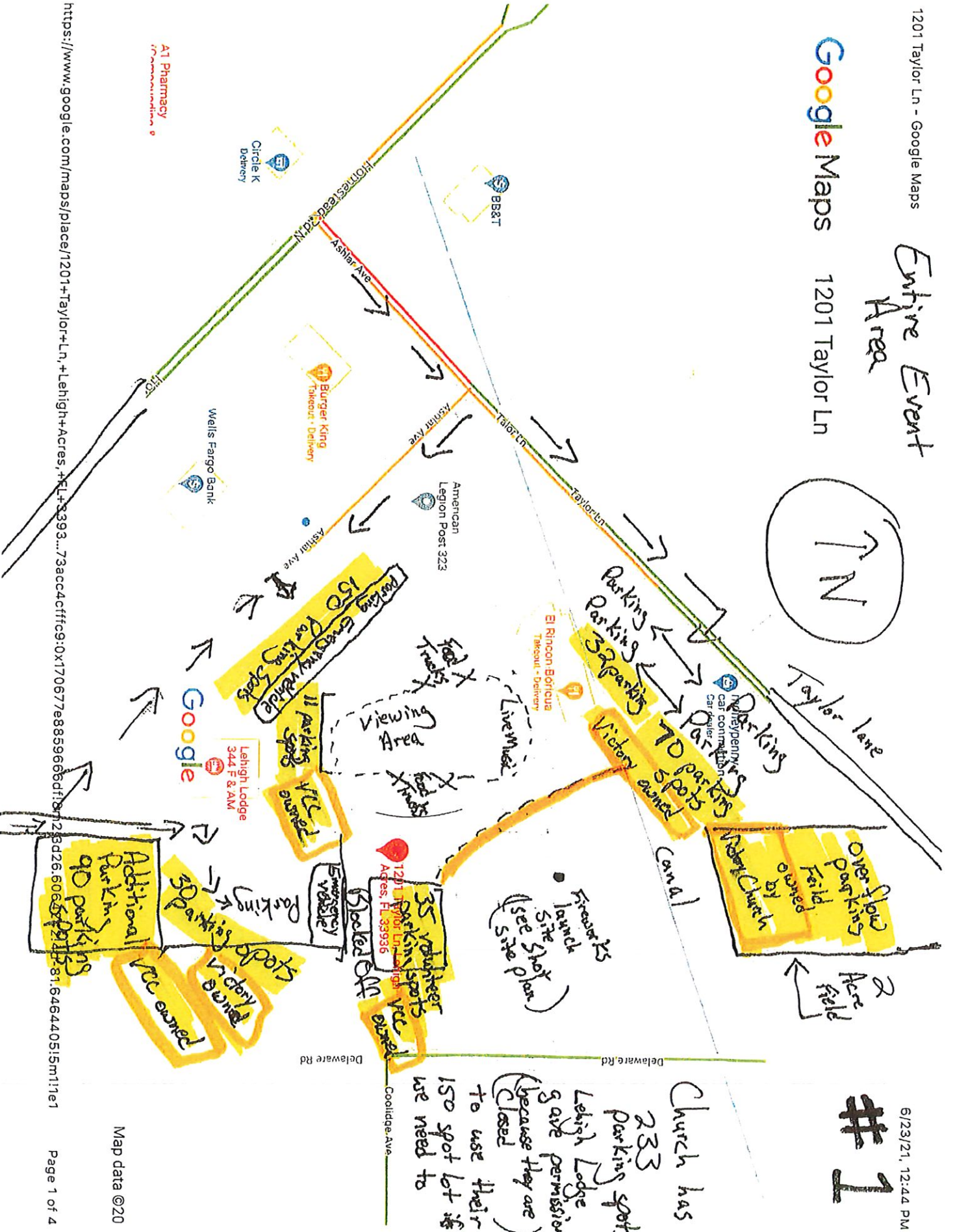
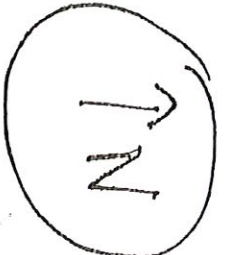

Entire Event Area



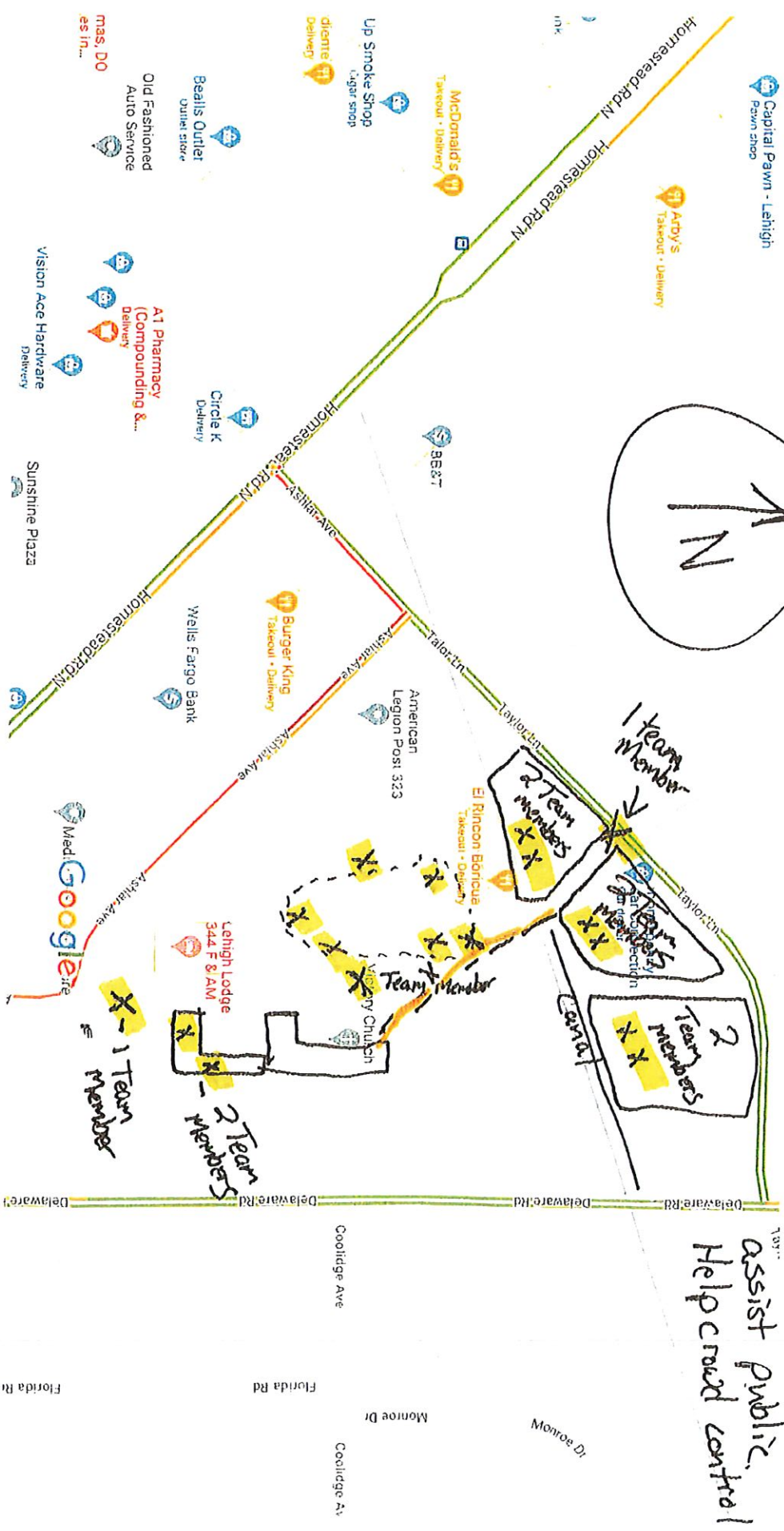

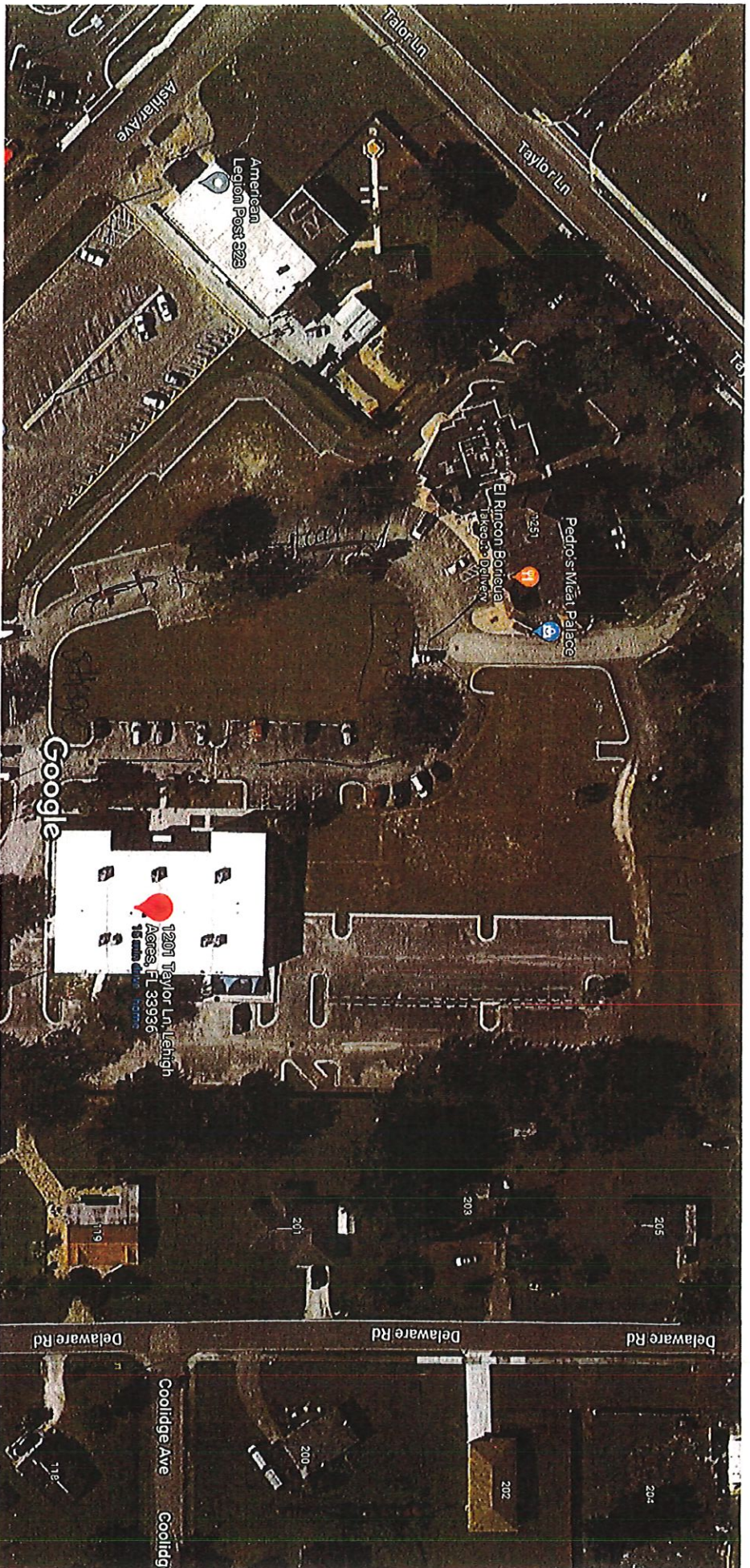
