LEE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 13-08

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR THE USE OF GOLF CARTS UPON DESIGNATED COUNTY ROADS ON PINE ISLAND.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Lee County, Florida is the governing body in and for Lee County, Florida, and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Lee County, Florida is authorized pursuant to Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, to enact Ordinances necessary in the exercise of its powers; and,

WHEREAS, citizens of the county have expressed an interest in allowing golf carts to be driven upon public roads and streets located on Pine Island; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 316.212(1), Florida Statutes, the County is permitted to allow golf carts to be operated on public County roads or streets after considering the speed, volume, and character of motor vehicle traffic using those roads and streets; and,

WHEREAS, the Lee County Department of Transportation has determined that golf carts may safely travel on or cross the Pine Island Roads as defined herein; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners hereby authorizes the operation of golf carts in a limited manner on certain designated county roads on Pine Island; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to provide additional regulations for the operation of golf carts on designated county roads on Pine Island; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners believes that regulations proposed in this Ordinance promote and enhance the health, safety and welfare of its citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

SECTION ONE: DEFINITIONS

- A. The term "Golf Cart" is defined as stated in Section 320.01(22), Florida Statutes, as a motor vehicle that is designed and manufactured for operation on a golf course for sporting or recreational purposes and that is not capable of exceeding speeds of twenty (20) miles per hour.
- B. The term "Pine Island" is that area of Pine Island west of the St. James Creek Bridge on Pine Island Road.

C. The term "Pine Island Roads" as used herein refers to the specific public roads, streets, or highways under the jurisdiction of Lee County on Pine Island and is owned, operated, and maintained by Lee County that are specifically designated for use by golf carts under this Ordinance. The term Pine Island Roads does not include Pine Island Road east of Stringfellow Road, or Stringfellow Road between the Jug Creek Bridge in Bokeelia and St. Jude Boulevard in St. James City.

SECTION TWO: USE OF GOLF CARTS UPON DESIGNATED COUNTY ROADS ON PINE ISLAND

- A. Golf carts may be operated on designated public Pine Island Roads or portions thereof as described in Attachment "A" (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Designated roads"). All persons who operate or ride in golf carts on roads do so at their risk and peril, and must be observant of, and attentive to the safety of themselves and others, including their passengers, other motorists, bicyclists, and pedestrians. The operation of a golf cart on Designated roads is strictly prohibited unless the golf cart is operated and equipped in full compliance with this Ordinance.
- B. In addition to the requirements of § 316.212, Florida Statutes, which are applicable to the operation of golf carts on public roads, the following restrictions will also apply to the operation of golf carts on Designated roads:
 - No person may operate or be in control of a golf cart on a Designated road on Pine Island unless such person is in possession of a valid driver's license issued in his or her home state or country.
 - 2) No person may operate golf carts on any bicycle paths, shared-use paths, or sidewalks on Pine Island.
 - 3) All golf carts operating subject to this Ordinance must be equipped with following safety equipment:
 - efficient brakes,
 - reliable steering apparatus,
 - safe tires.
 - a rearview mirror,
 - red reflectorized warning devices in both the front and rear
 - 4) Golf carts may not be operated on public roads between the hours of sunset and sunrise.
 - 5) The number of occupants in any golf cart being operated on the designated streets will be limited to the number of seats on the golf

- cart. No occupant of a golf cart is allowed to stand while the golf cart is in motion.
- 6) Operation of a golf cart in an unsafe manner is prohibited.
- Golf carts may not be operated in a manner that will obstruct or interfere with normal traffic flow.
- 8) Golf carts may not be driven or parked in drainage or landscape areas adjacent to the Designated roads.
- Operators of golf carts are required to observe all applicable state and local traffic laws as if they were operating any other motor vehicle.
- 10) While traveling on Designated roads, operators and passengers of golf carts must comply with all applicable State laws.
- C. The Lee County Department of Transportation will post signs along the designated roads where golf cart operation is allowed advising motorists of the possible presence of golf cart traffic and alerting the public that the operation of such golf carts is subject to the various requirements of this Ordinance. The Lee County Department of Transportation will also designate and post, when appropriate, golf cart crossing paths across Stringfellow and Pine Island Roads, as well as other Designated roads.
- D. Nothing in this Ordinance may be construed to restrict the use of golf carts or similar equipment for landscaping, maintenance, trash control, or similar work on private property adjacent to County roads.

SECTION THREE: TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OR TERMINATION OF USE OF GOLF CARTS ON DESIGNATED ROADS

If the Director of the Lee County Department of Transportation finds that operation of golf carts on a Designated road presents a significant threat to public health, safety, or welfare, the Director may temporarily restrict or terminate the use of golf carts on the Designated road (or portion thereof) where the threat exists. The use of golf carts will be restricted or prohibited until such time as the threat is remedied. If the threat is not of a temporary nature or cannot be remedied, this Ordinance must be amended to permanently terminate the authority to operate golf carts on the Designated road (or portion thereof) in question.

SECTION FOUR: PENALTIES AND ENFORCEMENT

Violations of this Section shall constitute a non-criminal infraction enforceable by all duly authorized law enforcement officers pursuant to the provisions of Sections 316.212(9) and 318, Florida Statutes.

SECTION FIVE: CODIFICATION AND SCRIVENER'S ERRORS

The Lee County Board of County Commissioners intends that this Ordinance will be made part of the Lee County Code; and that sections of this Ordinance can be renumbered or relettered and the word "Ordinance" can be changed to "Section", "Article", or some other appropriate word or phrase to accomplish codification, and regardless of whether this Ordinance is ever codified, the Ordinance can be renumbered or relettered and typographical errors and clarification of ambiguous wording that do not affect the intent can be corrected with the authorization of the County Manager or his designee, without the need for public hearing.

SECTION SIX: CONFLICT OF LAW

In the event this Ordinance conflicts with any other Ordinance of Lee County or other applicable law, the more restrictive shall apply. If any phrase or portion of the Ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion.

SECTION SEVEN: SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Ordinance are severable and it is the legislative intention to confer upon the whole or any part of the Ordinance the powers herein provided for. If any provision of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the decision of such court shall not affect or impair any remaining provisions of the Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional provision not been included herein.

SECTION EIGHT: EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its filing with the Office of the Secretary of the Florida Department of State.
