Lee County Government to close two post-Hurricane Milton comfort stations

Fort Myers, FL, Nov. 6, 2024 – Lee County Government will close two post-Hurricane Milton comfort stations Friday afternoon because of the decrease in residents using the temporary facilities.

The comfort stations that will be closed by 5 p.m. Nov. 8 are:

- Boca Grande: 240 Banyan St. at the rear parking lot of Island School and Community Center.
- Matlacha: 4577 Pine Island Road in Matlacha Community Park.

Comfort stations are set up immediately following storms in heavily impacted communities as a temporary measure to assist with laundry, showers, restrooms and internet connectivity until the recovery process is further along.
