INSTRUCTIONS

- A. The Letter of Substantial Compliance must be filled out completely, signed and sealed by the MDO Development Order Landscape Architect of Record.
- B. A request for final inspection must accompany the Letter of Substantial Compliance.
- C. Changes:
 - 1. If the as-built construction contains minor changes from the approved MDO Development Order plans that are inconsequential and which do not substantially effect the technical requirements of the LDC, an Application for a Minor Change (see LDC Section 10-120) may be submitted along with the letter of substantial compliance.

Pursuant to LDC Section 10-183(a), please submit:

- a. A site plan, highlighting the changes, and sealed by the Landscape Architect.
- b. A list of the changes in letter form.
- 2. If the as-built construction contains changes from the approved MDO Development Order plans that affect the technical requirements of the LDC or which exceed the limitations of LDC Section 10-120 for minor changes, an Application for an Amendment (see LDC Section 10-118) must be submitted and approved prior to submission of a Letter of Substantial Compliance by the Landscape Architect.
