- Jami Browder discussed two RFA's out. RFA for COC domestic violence bonus project due September 18th by 5PM. RFA out for CDBG Community public service and non-profit capitol due September 30th at 5PM.
- Kayla Towle announced Coordinated Entry handled 964 calls in August. So far in September,
 Coordinated Entry handled 232 calls.
- The HVS HOT Team in partnership with other organizations, diverted 8 individuals from homelessness in August and 4 individuals in September.
- HMIS report showed our community housed 14 individuals who are experiencing homelessness in August and two individuals in September.
- There were two Outreach events in the month of August. HVS partnered with Centerstone, LCSO, FMPD, LeeTran, JSCS, VA, and Kimmies Recovery Zone. Multiple people were connected to resources.

IV. Lee County Homeless Coalition – General CoC Membership Update

- In August the coalition housed 3 4 people and helped several seniors get into housing.
- The Coalition was rewarded a \$100,000 grant that is targeting homeless youth. The grant is to help with housing or college dorms. Youth between 15 and 22 years of age are eligible.
- There is an upcoming presentation with PJ Brooks from CASL. He's going to be presenting on healthcare. PJ will also be at the Florida coalition and homelessness conference. The conference has about 450 participates.
