ROADWATCH UPDATE
December 19, 2024 to December 25, 2024

1. Road Work/Maintenance/Improvement

Corkscrew Road Widening Project – Phase 2 Construction Project: The project constructs four, 11-foot-wide travel lanes from Bella Terra Boulevard to just east of Alico Road, and a new traffic signal at the Alico Road intersection. Also included are on-road bike lanes in each direction, a 10-foot-wide shared-use path on the south side of the road, a 6-foot sidewalk on the north side of the road, and street lighting. The 22-foot wide (varies) median includes various hardwood and palm trees as well as shrubs.

Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists are urged to use extra caution when traveling through the work zone.

- Expect limited work activities over the holidays. No lane closures are anticipated.
- Motorists should expect crews to be working on underground utilities near the intersection of Corkscrew Road and Alico Road. The contractor will be doing initial work for the traffic signal installation.
- Crews may be performing earthwork close to the roadway. Please be aware that trucks may be entering and leaving Corkscrew Road.
- Crews are installing water main from Wayside Lane to Alico Road.
- Crews are installing a force main on both sides of Corkscrew Road.
- During daytime hours, the contractor continues earthwork as a part of the new pond construction east of Corkscrew Shores.
- Crews are installing erosion control and traffic control devices throughout the project.
- Crews may be working close to the roadway. Motorists are asked to drive with caution. Sidewalks may be closed in areas throughout the project as the contractor performs underground work.

The work activities above are scheduled to occur, however unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

Please use caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the roadway. **Estimated completion is spring 2026.** Project cost is approximately \$27 M. The contractor is Bergeron Land Development, Inc. Sanibel Causeway Emergency Restoration: Crews have moved traffic to the permanent lanes on the Sanibel Causeway. The causeway islands surrounding the temporary roadway are an active work zone and are currently closed for public access, including from the water. Expect limited work activities over the holidays. No new lane closures are scheduled.

The following work activities above are scheduled to occur, however unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

East of the Toll Plaza:

- **The contractor is scheduled to open two, westbound lanes on McGregor Boulevard on Friday, December 20, 2024.** The reconstruction of the underground pipe crossing is complete. Paving of this area is scheduled to occur this week. Currently both directions of McGregor Boulevard traffic are shifted to the south side of the road from approximately ½ mile from Shell Point Boulevard to west of Port Comfort Road. Westbound traffic headed to Port Comfort Road may continue straight to turn right to Port Comfort Road.
- Motorists should continue to expect the outside eastbound travel lane of McGregor Boulevard to remain closed from the toll plaza to approximately ¾ miles east. The shoulder on McGregor Boulevard remains FULLY CLOSED TO ACCESS. Crews are scheduled to pave this area this week. The contractor is scheduled to stabilize the shoulder in early 2025.
- Outside of the holidays, motorists can continue to expect temporary daytime flagging on McGregor Boulevard, both eastbound and westbound from Shell Point Boulevard to Punta Rassa Road for crews to move equipment and materials as necessary.

West of the Toll Plaza:

- Crews will begin removing barrier wall along the causeway islands in preparation for final asphalt. THE CAUSEWAY ISLANDS PARK REMAINS CLOSED TO PUBLIC ACCESS.
- Lee County is installing a post & rope system to temporarily delineate pedestrian traffic on the causeway islands during the upcoming recreational facility reconstruction.
- Motorists should expect traffic to be intermittently stopped at the staging area entrance as equipment crosses the road with materials for work on the south side of McGregor Boulevard and on the south side of the toll plaza.
- The westbound merge location is now west of the toll plaza. Motorists are urged to use caution and obey the 20 MPH speed limit. Construction vehicles and equipment continue to enter/exit the staging area near this location.

- Crews continue work in the area of the off-island U-turn under Span A.
- Many oversized vehicles are crossing the causeway to assist with recovery efforts on the island. Please be patient as travel may be slower than usual. Bicyclists are encouraged to utilize another mode of transportation to travel the causeway. Pedestrians are not permitted on the Sanibel Causeway.

MOTORISTS ARE REMINDED TO OBEY THE POSTED SPEED LIMIT OF 20 MPH. Please use caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the roadway. Big Carlos Pass Bridge Project – Construction Project: The project builds a new bridge over Big Carlos Pass, from Estrellita Drive on Fort Myers Beach to the Lovers Key State Park bayside entrance on Lovers Key. The new bridge will replace the existing moveable bridge over Big Carlos Pass with a fixed span bridge that will provide a vertical navigation clearance of 60 feet. The new bridge will be constructed on the Gulf side of the existing bridge, and will include one travel lane in each direction, bicycle lanes, a six-foot-wide sidewalk along the north side of Estero Boulevard, and a 10-foot-wide shared use path along the south side of Estero Boulevard. A parking area with access to the Lovers Key State Park will be included on the southeast side of the bridge. The project also includes relocation of existing infrastructure for Lee County Utilities and Bonita Springs Utilities.

*Boaters are reminded to avoid the construction equipment and the temporary trestle that is in the water.
Please use the channel when traveling through Big Carlos Pass.

- Expect limited work activities over the holidays. No lane closures are anticipated.
- During the very early morning hours, the contractor is taking delivery of concrete. Crews are pouring early to ensure the concrete is delivered timely and temperatures are favorable for successful pours. This is scheduled to continue through March 31 when sea turtle nesting season begins.
- Pedestrians should follow signs when traversing the construction area. Locations of work activities may change throughout the week.
- The contractor will continue driving additional piles for the bridge and construction of the trestle. The contractor will be building the bridge from this temporary trestle. Pile driving will continue through the duration of the project.
- Crews will continue performing earthwork throughout the project area.

- Trolley stops are available at the south entrance to Black Island (Lovers Key Resort) for those traveling to Fort Myers Beach and across the street from Black Island (Lovers Key Resort) for those traveling to Lovers Key and Bonita Springs. Travelers are asked to wait behind the concrete barrier until ready to board the trolley.

Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists are urged to use extra caution when traveling through the work zone as workers and construction vehicles are entering and leaving the roadway. Motorists should expect reduced speeds throughout the project area. Draw bridge will remain in operation during construction and motorists should be prepared to stop. Fishing from the Big Carlos Pass Bridge is restricted due to construction activities.

Estimated completion is summer 2026. Project cost is approximately \$90.8 M. The contractor is Superior Construction. Leisure Lane to Del Prado Boulevard N along US 41 - North Fort Myers (FDOT Permit #2022-H-192-00135): Accurate Drilling Systems, Inc. will be performing utility improvements beginning **Monday, October 30, 2023, and will continue through January 15, 2025.** Asphalt pavement, concrete sidewalk, concrete curbing, and utility improvements will be performed. Littleton Road Widening Project from Corbett Road to US 41: The project widens Littleton Road from the Corbett Road roundabout east to US 41. The new road segment will include an 11-foot-wide travel lane in each direction and a 12-foot-wide center turn lane with landscaped planting islands. The project began in January 2024 with estimated completion in summer 2025. Project cost is approximately \$20 million. The contractor is Wright Construction Group, Inc.

- Expect limited work activities over the holidays. No lane closures are anticipated.
- Motorists are advised that eastbound and westbound traffic have shifted to the south side of the corridor throughout the length of the project to allow crews to work on the north side.
- Crews continue to install drainage structures within the project limits. Motorists should expect to see flagging operations with minimal delays from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM.
- Motorists are advised that traffic may be heavy on weekdays from 7:00 AM to 8:30 AM and from 1:30 PM to 3:30 PM due to Littleton Elementary School traffic. Expect delays. Please choose an alternative route if possible.

- Two eastbound LeeTran bus stops on Littleton Road near Horizon Boulevard and Serendipity Boulevard are temporarily out of service. The bus stop on the corner of Littleton Road and US-41/North Cleveland Avenue near 7-Eleven is still in service.
- As requested by Windmill Village management, the driveway at Windmill Boulevard will remain closed until construction has progressed away from the area. Motorists entering and exiting Windmill Village are advised to continue using the Delft Avenue driveway during this closure.

The work activities above are scheduled to occur, however unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

MOTORISTS ARE ADVISED THAT LITTLETON ROAD IS AN ACTIVE CONSTRUCTION ZONE. THE SPEED LIMIT IS 30 MPH THROUGHOUT THE WORK ZONE. SPEEDING FINES ARE DOUBLED WHEN WORKERS ARE PRESENT.

Ortiz Avenue Widening from SR 884 (Colonial Boulevard) to SR 82 (Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard): This project consists of widening of Ortiz Avenue from 2 lanes to 4 lanes and constructs a six-foot sidewalk on the east side of the road and a 10-foot paved trail on the west side of the road. An on-road bike lane on both sides of the road will also be included. New street lighting will be installed, and a grass median will separate traffic. No improvements will be made at the roundabout intersection with Hanson Street. The contractor will reconstruct the roadway with drainage improvements and stormwater management facilities. Work also includes installation of new water main and installation of new reclaimed water and sewer facilities for Lee County and the City of Fort Myers.

Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists are urged to use extra caution when traveling through the work zone.

- Expect limited work activities over the holidays. No lane closures are anticipated.
- Pedestrian detours are expected on the shared use path in front of Vistas at Eastwood Apartments (across from the Lee County Jail) for utility work.
- LeeTran has installed a new temporary northbound bus stop just south of the Lee County Jail driveway. The northbound stops just north of the Lee County Jail driveway and near RaceTrac are temporarily out of service.
- Crews will continue earthwork activities.
- The contractor is scheduled to survey the project during daytime hours.
- Crews will be installing force main and water main north and south of the roundabout.
- The contractor is identifying existing utility locations throughout the project.

The work activities above are scheduled to occur, however unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

Motorists are asked to drive with caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the work zone. **Estimated completion is Spring 2026.** Project cost is approximately \$31 M. Gateway - FGUA Bulk Water Interconnect - Fort Myers (ROW2024-00503): Accurate Drilling Systems, Inc. will be performing installation of 12" watermain along Griffin Drive/Ray Avenue/Nobel Avenue to interconnect the Gateway and FGUA systems by Open, HDD and Jack and Bore methods, **beginning on Monday, June 24, 2024, and continuing through March 1, 2025.** The intersection of Ray Avenue S and Meadow Road will be subject to lane closures. The right lane of Northbound traffic on Ray Avenue S, just after Meadow Road, will be subject to lane closures, as well as the right lane of Northbound traffic on Nobel Avenue S, just after 28th St SW, will be subject to lane closures. Three Oaks Parkway Extension Project Phase 1 from Fiddlesticks Canal to Indian Paint Lane: This project consists of extending Three Oaks Parkway north of the Fiddlesticks Canal and constructs 4 lanes with a 5-foot-wide bicycle lane. In Phase 1, there is an 8-foot-wide sidewalk on the west side of the roadway and a 6-foot-wide sidewalk on the east side of the roadway.

- The outside northbound lane of Three Oaks Parkway, from Alico Road to Fiddlesticks Canal, will have intermittent lane closures for light pole installation.

Motorists are asked to drive with caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the work zone. **Estimated completion is early 2026.** Project cost is approximately \$26.8 M. Bonita Beach Road SE – Bonita Springs (ROW2024-00090): Thompkins Contracting, Inc. will be performing roadway and sidewalk improvements beginning **Wednesday, November 27, 2024,** and continue through **December 22, 2024.** Asphalt pavement, concrete sidewalk, concrete curbing, and drainage improvements will be performed. The outside (right) lane of Westbound traffic on Bonita Beach Road SE just after Bonita Grande Drive will be subject to lane closures, as will one of two lanes from the eastbound portion of Bonita Beach Road just after Trade Way One. Periodic lane closures for westbound

Removal of and repair of damaged concrete sidewalk will be performed on the East side of Ortiz Avenue, North of E Michigan Avenue TO Dean Street in Fort Myers. The outside (right) lane of northbound Ortiz Avenue will be subject to lane closures utilizing FDOT indexes 102-603 & 102-605. Also, the sidewalks will be closed and detoured as needed per Index FDOT 102-660. Periodic lane closures for northbound lanes of Ortiz Avenue will occur between the hours of **9:00 AM and 3:30 PM** on weekdays.
