ROADWATCH UPDATE July 25, 2024 to July 31, 2024

1. Road Work/Maintenance/Improvement

Corkscrew Road Widening Project – Phase I Construction Project: The project widens Corkscrew Road to six lanes from Ben Hill Griffin Parkway to Fire House Lane, and to four lanes from Fire House Lane to Bella Terra Boulevard. The project includes adding on-road bike lanes, some sidewalk, installing new drainage, and constructing a wildlife crossing approximately 1000 feet west of the entrance to Cypress Shadows Boulevard. This crossing will coincide with a regional flow-way that crosses Corkscrew Road at that location. The Village of Estero will be installing shared use paths, lighting, and landscaping as phasing allows. Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists are urged to use extra caution when traveling through the work zone. Please be aware of shifts in travel lanes and bike lanes, sidewalk detours, and miscellaneous turn lane closures.

Please use caution and drive with courtesy and patience throughout the project area. Residents are entering and exiting communities on both sides of Corkscrew Road.

The following information is provided by Cougar Contracting, Inc.:

- Corkscrew Road is now in its final configuration from Ben Hill Griffin Parkway to Bella Terra Boulevard. Motorists should expect isolated flagging operations with periodic lane closures as the contractor works through the final project punch list. Motorists should also expect construction vehicles entering and leaving the roadway.
- Crews continue installing signage, sod, and fencing throughout the project.

The work activities above are scheduled to occur, however unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

WORK PERFORMED BY OTHERS:

- GL Homes is actively working in the RiverCreek Community site across from Wild Blue Boulevard. Motorists should expect delays and use caution as construction vehicles enter/exit the roadway.
- The Village of Estero anticipates beginning construction of their shared use path in fall 2024. The path is designed to extend to the east property line of Bella Terra on the south side and to east of Grandezza on the north side of Corkscrew Road.

MOTORISTS ARE REMINDED TO OBEY THE POSTED SPEED LIMIT. FOR EVERYONE'S SAFETY, PLEASE STAY OUT OF THE ACTIVE WORK ZONE.

Please use caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the roadway. **Estimated completion of the full project is summer 2024**. Project cost is approximately \$23 M. The contractor is Cougar Contracting, LLC. Corkscrew Road Widening Project – Phase 2 Construction Project: The project constructs four, 11-foot-wide travel lanes from Bella Terra Boulevard to just east of Alico Road, and a new traffic signal at the Alico Road intersection. Also included are on-road bike lanes in each direction, a 10-foot-wide shared-use path on the south side of the road, a 6-foot sidewalk on the north side of the road, and street lighting. The 22-foot wide (varies) median includes various hardwood and palm trees as well as shrubs.

Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists are urged to use extra caution when traveling through the work zone.

- Crews will be installing conduit for streetlights and fiber communication lines from Wayside Lane to Alico Road on the south side of Corkscrew Road.
- Crews are installing water main from Wayside Lane to the eastern boundary of Corkscrew Shores.
- Crews are installing a force main on the north side of Corkscrew Road.
- During daytime hours, the contractor continues earthwork as a part of the new pond construction east of Corkscrew Shores.

- Crews are installing erosion control and traffic control devices throughout the project.
- Crews may be working close to the roadway. Motorists are asked to drive with caution. Sidewalks may be closed in areas throughout the project as the contractor performs underground work.

Please use caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the roadway. **Estimated completion is spring 2026**. Project cost is approximately \$27 M. The contractor is Bergeron further Land Development, Inc. Sanibel Causeway Emergency Restoration: Crews have moved traffic to the permanent lanes on the Sanibel Causeway. The causeway islands surrounding the temporary roadway are an active work zone and are currently closed for public access, including from the water.

East of the Toll Plaza:

- Motorists should expect temporary daytime lane closures on McGregor Boulevard, both
 eastbound and westbound from Shell Point Boulevard to Punta Rassa Road. These closures are
 necessary for crews to clear the median in preparation for the upcoming traffic shift scheduled
 for August.
- In early August, motorists should expect traffic to be REDUCED TO ONE LANE IN EACH DIRECTON on McGregor Boulevard for approximately a ½ mile from Shell Point Boulevard to west of Port Comfort Road. Traffic will shift to the north while crews work on the south side, and then to the south while they work on the north side while crews reconstruct an underground pipe crossing.
- Motorists should expect one lane of eastbound travel to continue from the toll plaza to Shell Point Road on the south (beach) side of McGregor Boulevard. The shoulder (south/beach side) remains FULLY CLOSED TO ACCESS. This closure is necessary for crews to excavate and install underground devices (marine mattresses) to reinforce the shoreline. This closure is expected to be in place through summer 2024. The contractor may intermittently use this lane for materials delivery.
- Motorists traveling westbound on McGregor Boulevard may experience short delays for FHP to stop vehicles to allow materials deliveries to access the staging area at Punta Rassa.

West of the Toll Plaza:

- Protected beach-nesting birds are currently present on the Causeway islands. Motorists are encouraged to slow down and pay attention as birds may be flying close to the roadway.
- Motorists should expect traffic to be intermittently stopped at the staging area entrance as equipment crosses the road with materials for work on the south side of McGregor Boulevard.
- Crews continue earthwork and debris removal along the causeway islands. Please expect construction equipment periodically entering/leaving the travel lanes when necessary. The contractor is limiting this interruption during peak hours.
- The westbound merge location is now west of the toll plaza. Motorists are urged to use caution and obey the 20 MPH speed limit. Construction vehicles and equipment continue to enter/exit the staging area near this location.
- Crews continue work in the area of the off-island U-turn under Span A.

Many oversized vehicles are crossing the causeway to assist with recovery efforts on the island. Please be patient as travel may be slower than usual. Bicyclists are encouraged to utilize another mode of transportation to travel the causeway and pedestrians are not permitted on the Sanibel Causeway.

MOTORISTS ARE REMINDED TO OBEY THE POSTED SPEED LIMIT OF 20 MPH. Please use caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the roadway. Big Carlos Pass Bridge Project – Construction Project: The project builds a new bridge over Big Carlos Pass, from Estrellita Drive on Fort Myers Beach to the Lovers Key State Park bayside entrance on Lovers Key. The new bridge will replace the existing moveable bridge over Big Carlos Pass with a fixed span bridge that will provide a vertical navigation clearance of 60 feet. The new bridge will be constructed on the Gulf side of the existing bridge, and will include one travel lane in each direction, bicycle lanes, a six-foot-wide sidewalk along the north side of Estero Boulevard, and a 10-foot-wide shared use path along the south side of Estero Boulevard. A parking area with access to the Lovers Key State Park will be included on the southeast side of the bridge. The project also includes relocation of existing infrastructure for Lee County Utilities and Bonita Springs Utilities.

Boaters are reminded to avoid the construction equipment and the temporary trestle that is in the water. Please use the channel when traveling through Big Carlos Pass.

Pedestrians and boaters are reminded to please stay out of the work zone.

- The contractor will continue driving additional piles for the bridge. The pile driving will be more continuous. Additional cranes and equipment are onsite to complete this work.
- Crews continue driving and installing pile as a part of the construction of the trestle. The contractor will be building the bridge from this temporary trestle. Pile driving will continue through the duration of the project.
- Crews will continue performing earthwork throughout the project area.
- Trolley stops are available at the south entrance to Black Island (Lovers Key Resort) for those traveling to Fort Myers Beach and across the street from Black Island (Lovers Key Resort) for those traveling to Lovers Key and Bonita Springs. Travelers are asked to wait behind the concrete barrier until ready to board the trolley.
- Pedestrians will be directed to use sidewalk on one side of the roadway through the construction area.

Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists are urged to use extra caution when traveling through the work zone as workers and construction vehicles are entering and leaving the roadway. Motorists should expect reduced speeds throughout the project area. Draw bridge will remain in operation during construction and motorists should be prepared to stop. Fishing from the Big Carlos Pass Bridge is restricted due to construction activities.

Estimated completion is summer 2026. Project cost is approximately \$90.8 M. The contractor is Superior Construction. North Lee County Wellfield Expansion Phase IIIA Project – Fort Myers (ROW2022-00030): Durrance Road between Deal Road to LCU North Water Treatment Plan - RPU will be completing the Raw Water Main tie-ins via open cut and testing of the Raw Water Main from May 28, through July 31, 2024. Work

will be performed along Durrance Road from Deal Road heading south towards LCU North Water Treatment Plant. Northbound lane will be subject to temporary daily lane closures. Traffic will be maintained with flagmen and opened up daily. Working hours shall be from **9:00 AM to 4:00 PM**. Leisure Lane to Del Prado Boulevard N along US 41 - North Fort Myers (FDOT Permit #2022-H-192-00135): Accurate Drilling Systems, Inc. will be performing utility improvements **beginning Monday**, **October 30, 2023, and will continue through September 19, 2024**. Asphalt pavement, concrete sidewalk, concrete curbing, and utility improvements will be performed. US 41 will not have any lane closures. Littleton Road Widening Project from Corbett Road to US 41: The project widens Littleton Road from the Corbett Road roundabout east to US 41. The new road segment will include an 11-foot-wide travel lane in each direction and a 12-foot-wide center turn lane with landscaped planting islands. The project began in January 2024 with estimated completion in summer 2025. Project cost is approximately \$20 million. The contractor is Wright Construction Group, Inc.

- On Monday, July 29, and Tuesday, July 30 (weather permitting) motorists should expect lane closures during daytime hours from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM while crews place new asphalt and install pavement markings for an upcoming traffic shift. Flaggers will be onsite to assist motorists, however delays are anticipated. Once the pavement markings are in place, both eastbound and westbound traffic will be shifted to the south side of the corridor to allow crews to work on the north side.
- As requested by Windmill Village management, the driveway at Windmill Boulevard will remain closed until construction has progressed away from the area. Motorists entering and exiting Windmill Village are advised to continue using the Delft Avenue driveway during this closure.
- Crews continue to install drainage structures within the project limits. Motorists should expect to see flagging operations with minimal delays from 5:00 AM to 5:00 PM.
- Motorists are advised that traffic has shifted to temporary asphalt on the north side of the existing Littleton Road from Janet Drive to Hutto Road.

The work activities above are scheduled to occur, however unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

MOTORISTS ARE ADVISED THAT LITTLETON ROAD IS AN ACTIVE CONSTRUCTION ZONE. THE SPEED LIMIT IS 30 MPH THROUGHOUT THE WORK ZONE. SPEEDING FINES ARE DOUBLED WHEN WORKERS ARE PRESENT.

Ortiz Avenue Widening from SR 884 (Colonial Boulevard) to SR 82 (Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard): This project consists of widening of Ortiz Avenue from 2 lanes to 4 lanes and constructs a six-foot sidewalk on the east side of the road and a 10-foot paved trail on the west side of the road. An onroad bike lane on both sides of the road will also be included. New street lighting will be installed, and a grass median will separate traffic. No improvements will be made at the roundabout intersection with Hanson Street. The contractor will reconstruct the roadway with drainage improvements and stormwater management facilities. Work also includes installation of new water main and installation of new reclaimed water and sewer facilities for Lee County and the City of Fort Myers.

Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists are urged to use extra caution when traveling through the work zone.

- Motorists should expect northbound lane closures at the north end of the project, close to the SR 82 interchange, for utility installations. Motorists will be able to turn left, right, or continue northbound, although turn lane lengths will be reduced and one northbound lane will be closed overnight. Please exercise caution when traveling through the project.
- Motorists should expect the northbound right turn lane into the RaceTrac gas station to be closed temporarily during the daytime hours for utility installations. Motorists can turn into the gas station directly from SR82.
- LeeTran has installed a new temporary northbound bus stop just south of the Lee County Jail driveway. The northbound stops just north of the Lee County Jail driveway and near RaceTrac are temporarily out of service.
- Crews will continue to mobilize equipment and materials to the project site.
- Crews will continue earthwork activities.
- The contractor is scheduled to survey the project during daytime hours.
- Crews will be installing force main and water main north of the roundabout.
- The contractor is identifying existing utility locations throughout the project.

The work activities above are scheduled to occur, however unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

Motorists are asked to drive with caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the work zone. **Estimated completion is Spring 2026.** Project cost is approximately \$31 M. Ben Hill Griffin Parkway Force Main Improvements - Fort Myers (ROW2023-01519): Accurate Drilling Systems, LLC. will be performing installation of 18" force main by Horizontal Directional Drill method, beginning on Thursday, March 4, 2024, and continuing through August 30, 2024. The outside (right) lane of northbound traffic on Ben Hill Griffin Blvd, between Garofalo Way and Corkscrew Rd, will be subject to lane closures. The closures will be in sections as we advance with the drilling activities. The closure of the northbound right lane will occur between the hours of 9:00 AM to 3:30 PM on weekdays. - 1. Sidewalk Removal and Installation (Project Timeline: April 15, 2024, to July 30, 2024):
 - Winkler Road Sidewalk Improvements: The Project Consists of sidewalk improvements along
 Winkler Road within Lee County, Florida. Starting north of Southwind Bay Circle, extending
 to Summerlin Road and Winkler Intersection Work shall include, but not be limited to,
 removing portions of existing sidewalk, realignment, new concrete, sidewalk installation with
 ADA upgrades, culvert installations, fill dirt, grading, final dress and sod.

Phase I Construction commenced on April 15, 2024. 184 LF south of Woodgate Drive on Winkler Road marks starting point of this phase. Phase I is in its final stages of completion.

Phase II Construction stretches the remainder of the Project, ending at the intersection of Summerlin Road & Winkler Road. Phase II Construction has been initiated.

- Motorists and Pedestrians should expect Maintenance of Traffic Operations, as crews set up MOT and start construction progression.

Work will continue on locations 9 - 18 off Palm Beach from **July 22, 2024 through July 26, 2024** and the last area will be locations 19 - 33 in Fort Myers Shores area from **July 29, 2024 through August 2, 2024**. Buckingham Road in front of Oakview Community – Fort Myers (ROW2024-03292): Mitchell & Stark Construction Company is scheduled to carry out roadway improvements, with construction set to commence during the week of May 20, 2024, and extend for the following three months until August 20, 2024. The current two-lane configuration in the area will necessitate periodic lane closures throughout the construction period. Daytime work will be conducted now that we are out of season. The planned activities within the right-of-way (ROW) area include jack and boring underneath Buckingham Road, milling and paving, as well as the addition of a deceleration lane and a turn lane.
