ROADWATCH UPDATE

January 16, 2025 to January 22, 2025

1. Road Work/Maintenance/Improvement

Corkscrew Road Widening Project – Phase 2 Construction Project: The project constructs four, 11-foot-wide travel lanes from Bella Terra Boulevard to just east of Alico Road, and a new traffic signal at the Alico Road intersection. Also included are on-road bike lanes in each direction, a 10-foot-wide shared-use path on the south side of the road, a 6-foot sidewalk on the north side of the road, and street lighting. The 22-foot wide (varies) median includes various hardwood and palm trees as well as shrubs.

Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists are urged to use extra caution when traveling through the work zone.

- Motorists should expect intermittent daytime flagging for crews to perform earthwork close to the roadway. Please be aware that trucks may be entering and leaving Corkscrew Road.
- Motorists should expect crews to be working on underground utilities near the intersection of Corkscrew Road and Alico Road. The contractor will be doing initial work for the traffic signal installation.
- Crews are installing water main from Wayside Lane to Alico Road.
- Crews are installing a force main on both sides of Corkscrew Road.
- During daytime hours, the contractor continues earthwork as a part of the new pond construction east of Corkscrew Shores.
- Crews are installing erosion control and traffic control devices throughout the project.
- Crews may be working close to the roadway. Motorists are asked to drive with caution. Sidewalks may be closed in areas throughout the project as the contractor performs underground work.

The work activities above are scheduled to occur, however unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

Please use caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the roadway. Estimated completion is spring 2026. Project cost is approximately \$27 M. The contractor is Bergeron Development, Inc. Sanibel Causeway Emergency Restoration: Crews have moved traffic to the permanent lanes on the Sanibel Causeway. The causeway islands surrounding the temporary roadway are an active work zone and are currently closed for public access, including from the water.

The following work activities above are scheduled to occur, however unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

West of the Toll Plaza:

- During the nighttime/overnight hours of 7:00 PM to 6:00 AM, motorists should expect one lane of travel with a flagging operation for the contractor to complete final paving of the roadway. This work is anticipated to be complete by the end of January.
- Motorists should expect intermittent flagging during daytime hours throughout the causeway for various work activities.
- Motorists should expect traffic to be intermittently stopped at the staging area entrance as
 equipment crosses the road with materials for work on the south side of McGregor Boulevard
 and on the south side of the toll plaza.
- Lee County is installing a post & rope system to temporarily delineate pedestrian traffic on the causeway islands during the upcoming recreational facility reconstruction. THE CAUSEWAY ISLANDS PARK REMAINS CLOSED TO PUBLIC ACCESS.
- Motorists are urged to use caution and obey the 20 MPH speed limit. Construction vehicles and equipment continue to enter/exit the travel lanes throughout the project.
- Crews continue work on the off-island U-turn under Span A.

East of the Toll Plaza:

- Motorists should expect eastbound and westbound lane closures on McGregor Boulevard from the toll plaza to Shell Point Boulevard for multiple work activities. The contractor expects to maintain at least one lane in each direction.
 - o Crews are currently restoring the median between Port Comfort Road and Punta Rassa Road. This work requires a westbound lane closure.
 - Crews will be restoring guardrail and the asphalt shoulder along eastbound McGregor Boulevard. This work requires the outside lane to be closed to allow crews to work safety on the south side of the roadway. The contractor expects to close this lane later this month.

- o The shoulder on McGregor Boulevard remains FULLY CLOSED TO ACCESS from the toll plaza to approximately ¾ miles east. The contractor is scheduled to stabilize the shoulder in March 2025.
- Motorists can continue to expect intermittent daytime flagging on McGregor Boulevard, both
 eastbound and westbound from Shell Point Boulevard to Punta Rassa Road for crews to move
 equipment and materials.

Many oversized vehicles are crossing the causeway to assist with recovery efforts on the island. Please be patient as travel may be slower than usual. Bicyclists are encouraged to utilize another mode of transportation to travel the causeway. Pedestrians are not permitted on the Sanibel Causeway.

MOTORISTS ARE REMINDED TO OBEY THE POSTED SPEED LIMIT OF 20 MPH. Please use caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the roadway. Big Carlos Pass Bridge Project – Construction Project: The project builds a new bridge over Big Carlos Pass, from Estrellita Drive on Fort Myers Beach to the Lovers Key State Park bayside entrance on Lovers Key. The new bridge will replace the existing moveable bridge over Big Carlos Pass with a fixed span bridge that will provide a vertical navigation clearance of 60 feet. The new bridge will be constructed on the Gulf side of the existing bridge, and will include one travel lane in each direction, bicycle lanes, a six-foot-wide sidewalk along the north side of Estero Boulevard, and a 10-foot-wide shared use path along the south side of Estero Boulevard. A parking area with access to the Lovers Key State Park will be included on the southeast side of the bridge. The project also includes relocation of existing infrastructure for Lee County Utilities and Bonita Springs Utilities.

Boaters are reminded to avoid the construction equipment and the temporary trestle that is in the water.

Please use the channel when traveling through Big Carlos Pass.

TRESSPASSING INTO THE CONSTRUCTION SITE IS DANGEROUS AND ILLEGAL. THIS INCLUDES THE BEACH AREA UNDER THE BRIDGE.

Pedestrians and boaters are reminded to please stay out of the work zone.

 Motorists should expect a daytime flagging operation beginning for crews to install temporary barrier wall along the bay side of the bridge. The contractor will be removing existing curb and guardrail. The flagging operation is anticipated to last through January.

- During the very early morning hours, the contractor is taking delivery of concrete. Crews are
 pouring early to ensure the concrete is delivered timely and temperatures are favorable for
 successful pours. This is scheduled to continue through March 31 when sea turtle nesting season
 begins.
- Pedestrians should follow signs when traversing the construction area. Locations of work activities may change throughout the week.
- The contractor will continue driving additional piles for the bridge and construction of the trestle. The contractor will be building the bridge from this temporary trestle. Pile driving will continue through the duration of the project.
- Crews will continue performing earthwork throughout the project area.
- Trolley stops are available at the south entrance to Black Island (Lovers Key Resort) for those traveling to Fort Myers Beach and across the street from Black Island (Lovers Key Resort) for those traveling to Lovers Key and Bonita Springs. Travelers are asked to wait behind the concrete barrier until ready to board the trolley.

Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists are urged to use extra caution when traveling through the work zone as workers and construction vehicles are entering and leaving the roadway. Motorists should expect reduced speeds throughout the project area. Draw bridge will remain in operation during construction and motorists should be prepared to stop. Fishing from the Big Carlos Pass Bridge is restricted due to construction activities.

Estimated completion is summer 2026. Project cost is approximately \$90.8 M. The contractor is Superior Construction. Littleton Road Widening Project from Corbett Road to US 41: The project widens Littleton Road from the Corbett Road roundabout east to US 41. The new road segment will include an 11-foot-wide travel lane in each direction and a 12-foot-wide center turn lane with landscaped planting islands. The project began in January 2024 with estimated completion in summer 2025. Project cost is approximately \$20 million. The contractor is Wright Construction Group, Inc.

- Crews are beginning roadway construction on the north side of Littleton Road, including curb
 work. Motorists should expect to see flagging operations with minimal delays from 9:00 AM to
 4:00 PM.
- Motorists are advised that eastbound and westbound traffic have shifted to the south side of the corridor throughout the length of the project to allow crews to work on the north side.
- Motorists are advised that traffic may be heavy on weekdays from 7:00 AM to 8:30 AM and from 1:30 PM to 3:30 PM due to Littleton Elementary School traffic. Expect delays. Please choose an alternative route if possible.

- Two eastbound LeeTran bus stops on Littleton Road near Horizon Boulevard and Serendipity Boulevard are temporarily out of service. The bus stop on the corner of Littleton Road and US-41/North Cleveland Avenue near 7-Eleven is still in service.
- As requested by Windmill Village management, the driveway at Windmill Boulevard will remain closed until construction has progressed away from the area. Motorists entering and exiting Windmill Village are advised to continue using the Delft Avenue driveway during this closure.

The work activities above are scheduled to occur, however unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

MOTORISTS ARE ADVISED THAT LITTLETON ROAD IS AN ACTIVE CONSTRUCTION ZONE. THE SPEED LIMIT IS 30 MPH THROUGHOUT THE WORK ZONE. SPEEDING FINES ARE DOUBLED WHEN WORKERS ARE PRESENT.

Ortiz Avenue Widening from SR 884 (Colonial Boulevard) to SR 82 (Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard): This project consists of widening of Ortiz Avenue from 2 lanes to 4 lanes and constructs a six-foot sidewalk on the east side of the road and a 10-foot paved trail on the west side of the road. An onroad bike lane on both sides of the road will also be included. New street lighting will be installed, and a grass median will separate traffic. No improvements will be made at the roundabout intersection with Hanson Street. The contractor will reconstruct the roadway with drainage improvements and stormwater management facilities. Work also includes installation of new water main and installation of new reclaimed water and sewer facilities for Lee County and the City of Fort Myers.

Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists are urged to use extra caution when traveling through the work zone.

- From Friday, January 17, 2025 to Tuesday, January 21, 2025, weather permitting, the entrance of Seventh Day Adventist Church will be reduced to one lane during daytime hours for utility installations. Flaggers will be onsite to assist motorists.
- LeeTran has installed a new temporary northbound bus stop just south of the Lee County Jail driveway. The northbound stops just north of the Lee County Jail driveway and near RaceTrac are temporarily out of service.
- Crews will continue earthwork activities.
- The contractor is scheduled to survey the project during daytime hours.
- Crews will be installing drainage north of the roundabout, and force main and water main south of the roundabout.

• The contractor is identifying existing utility locations throughout the project.

The work activities above are scheduled to occur, however unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

Motorists are asked to drive with caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the work zone. **Estimated completion is Spring 2026**. Project cost is approximately \$31 M. The contractor is OHLA USA. Gateway - FGUA Bulk Water Interconnect - Fort Myers (ROW2024-00503): Accurate Drilling Systems, Inc. will be performing installation of 12" watermain along Griffin Drive/Ray Avenue/Nobel Avenue to interconnect the Gateway and FGUA systems by Open, HDD and Jack and Bore methods, beginning on Monday, June 24, 2024, and continuing through March 1, 2025. The intersection of Ray Avenue S and Meadow Road will be subject to lane closures. The right lane of Northbound traffic on Ray Avenue S, just after Meadow Road, will be subject to lane closures, as well as the right lane of Northbound traffic on Nobel Avenue S, just after 28th St SW, will be subject to lane closures. The closures will be in sections as we advance with restoration efforts. The closure of the lanes will be during nights on weekdays from 7:00 PM - 6:00AM. Three Oaks Parkway Extension Project Phase 1 from Fiddlesticks Canal to Indian Paint Lane: This project consists of extending Three Oaks Parkway north of the Fiddlesticks Canal and constructs 4 lanes with a 5-foot-wide bicycle lane. In Phase 1, there is an 8-foot-wide sidewalk on the west side of the roadway and a 6-foot-wide sidewalk on the east side of the roadway.

• The outside northbound lane of Three Oaks Parkway, from Alico Road to Fiddlesticks Canal, will have intermittent lane closures for light pole installation.

Motorists are asked to drive with caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the work zone. **Estimated completion is early 2026**. Project cost is approximately \$26.8 M. The contractor is Wright Construction Group. Bonita Beach Road SE – Bonita Springs (ROW2024-00090): Thompkins Contracting, Inc. will be performing roadway and sidewalk improvements beginning Wednesday, November 27, 2024, and continuing through January 16, 2025. Asphalt pavement, concrete sidewalk, concrete curbing, and drainage improvements will be performed. The outside (right) lane of Westbound traffic on Bonita Beach Road SE just after Bonita Grande Drive will be subject to lane closures, as will one of two lanes from the eastbound portion of Bonita Beach Road just after Trade Way One. Periodic lane closures for westbound and eastbound lanes will occur between the hours of 7:00 PM and 6:00 AM on weekdays. Bell Boulevard Sidewalk from SR 82 to Sunrise Boulevard: Lee County is constructing a new 6-foot-wide concrete sidewalk on the east side of Bell Boulevard from SR 82 approximately 4.2 miles north to Sunrise Boulevard. Work includes concrete driveway replacements, minor roadway reconstruction and paving, minor drainage improvements, and signing and pavement markings. The project began in late October 2024 with estimated completion in summer 2025. Project cost is approximately \$3.2 M. The contractor is V&H Construction.

Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists are urged to use extra caution when traveling through the work zone.

- Beginning the week of January 20, 2025, crews will be milling and resurfacing intersections throughout the project area. Motorists should expect heavy trucks and equipment on the roadway. Please pay attention to traffic control devices.
- Motorists should expect periodic flagging throughout the project.
- Crews are installing drainage and pouring sidewalk throughout the project. This work will require some tree removal, installation of tree root barriers, and work across driveways.
- Crews are installing and maintaining erosion control and traffic control devices throughout the project.
- The contractor is identifying existing utility locations throughout the project. Crews may be working close to the roadway. Motorists are asked to drive with caution.

The work activities above are scheduled to occur, however unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

Boatways Road – Fort Myers (ROW2024-00795): Diversified Underground Utility Services, Inc., will be performing roadway and sidewalk improvements **beginning Monday**, **December 2**, **2024**, **and continuing through Friday**, **January 31**, **2025**. We are closing the roadway to perform a water tap, install a new water main, restore the asphalt in roadway, and new sidewalk, curb and sod remediation. Both lanes on Boatways Road will be subject to lane closures, as will the right turn lane from the southbound portion of Orange River Boulevard. Lane closures for both lanes will occur 24/7 from **6:00 AM on December 2**, **2024 to December 13**, **2024**, **at 4:00 PM**.
