ACTION REQUESTED: Approve Bid Waiver #W-020292 to waive the formal quotation procedure and allow Lee County DOT – Operations to purchase one (1) new Kaiser 2002 S2.2 Gator Swampmiester excavator from Pioneer Kaiser Inc.; which is the only authorized United States sales company for the sole source manufacturer of this machinery, the Kaiser Company, at a price of \$190,000.00. (Machine cost: \$215,000.00 less trade-in allowance of \$25,000.00 for a County-owned Kaiser Swampmiester = \$190,000.00.)

WHY ACTION IS NECESSARY: According to Section 9.4.1 of the Lee County Purchasing & Payment Procedures Manual, approved by the Board on 3/21/00, purchases over \$50,000.00 must be approved by the Board.

WHAT ACTION ACCOMPLISHES: This new equipment will provide DOT – Operations with the ability to maintain and adjust to an increasing level of service. This equipment cleans canals, ditches and swampy areas. The addition of this equipment will also provide for replacement service when like equipment is being repaired or maintained.

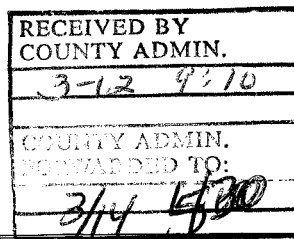
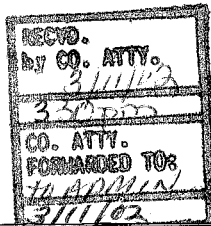

--BACKGROUND CONTINUED FROM PAGE ONE--

On February 21, 2002, the Division of Purchasing received a request from the Lee County Division of Fleet Management to waive the formal quotation procedure and purchase one (1) new Kaiser 2002 S2.2 Gator Swampmiester excavator from Pioneer Kaiser Inc.; which is the only authorized United States sales company for the sole source manufacturer of this machinery, the Kaiser Company, at a price of \$190,000.00; for use by Lee County DOT - Operations.

It should be noted that the bottom line price includes a trade-in: machine cost: \$215,000.00 less trade-in allowance of \$25,000.00 for a County-owned Kaiser Swampmiester = \$190,000.00.

This request for a bid waiver is predicated on, and justified by, the following factors:

*Flood Control via Canal Maintenance. The Swampmiesters presently in the County's fleet are used almost exclusively to clean and mow drainage canals where conventional equipment cannot perform these tasks due to wet and hard to reach terrain. The County's canals are its primary system and means of flood control. This new Swampmiester is needed to ensure that DOT has the equipment necessary to adequately maintain this canal system.

*Productivity and Safety. Lee County has been using Kaiser Swampmiesters for its canal maintenance for over 15 years. County equipment operators are familiar with the machine and its capabilities and controls. Therefore, operator and machine productivity are at their maximum levels immediately. There is no learning curve during which vital canal maintenance suffers. Further, since operators have a full understanding of the machine's limitations; the equipment is operated within known safety parameters; virtually eliminating the possibility of a costly accident due to operator error.

*Cost Savings via Standardization. The purchase of the same brand and type of machine as Lee County presently has in its fleet means that many of the spare parts and component parts already in inventory may be used interchangeably. Cost savings are achieved due to the fact that spares for an entirely different make and model of machine do not have to be stocked and inventoried. Further savings are achieved since County mechanics are already trained on, and are familiar with, the Kaiser equipment and its maintenance and repair.

*Sole Source. The Kaiser Swampmiester is a patented design (U.S. Pat. No. 4 395 191). Therefore, it is not available from another source; and there are no other competing machines which share its technology and design. It is available only through Pioneer Kaiser Inc. (see Attachment #2).

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approve a Bid Waiver for the sole source purchase of (1) one Kaiser 2002 S2.2 Gator Swampmiester from Pioneer Kaiser. Please refer to supporting documents attached. The extended cost for all components is \$215,000 less trade in value of \$25,000. Total purchase price is \$190,000.

WHY ACTION IS NECESSARY:

Section 11.0.3.1 of the Lee County Purchasing and Payment Procedures Manual exempts "the purchase of equipment that has gone through the Administrative Code Procedure, such as State Contracts or Federal General Services Administration Schedules, providing the purchase, rental, or lease amount does not exceed \$50,000.00." As this expenditure will exceed \$50,000.00, Board approval is necessary.

WHAT ACTION ACCOMPLISHES:

This new equipment will provide D.O.T. Operations with the ability to maintain and adjust to an increasing level of service. This equipment cleans canals, ditches and swampy areas. The addition of this equipment will also provide replacement service when like equipment is being repaired or maintained.

Lee County Fleet Management received a request from D.O.T. Operations to purchase a Kaiser Gator Swamp Miester. This is a replacement purchase for their fleet. 
