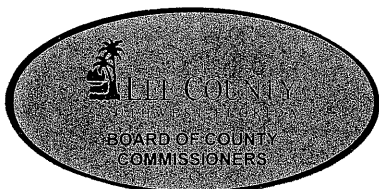

RESOLUTION

- Whereas: Matthew D. Milligan became a Cub Scout in 1993 and a Boy Scout in August 1996; and
- Whereas: Matthew received the Arrow of Light Award in 1996, the Top Boy Scout Popcorn Sales-Southwest Florida Council in 1998 and 2000, the "Do the Right Thing" Award in 1999 and was the recipient of the 2002 Uncommon Friends Scholarship. Matthew served as the Patrol Quarter Master, Assistant Patrol Leader, Patrol Leader, Patrol Scribe, Scoutmasters Camporee Junior Leader Staff in 1999, the 2001 National Jamboree Patrol Quartermaster and Chaplains Aide and Junior Assistant Scout Master, Wood Badge Youth Staff in 2002; and
- Whereas: Matthew D. Milligan achieved the highest rank in Scouting, The Eagle, on September 19, 2001 and received it at a ceremony on March 23, 2002; and
- Whereas: The Eagle Scout Badge represents accomplishments in Scouting skills, in teamwork as a member and leader of this troop and/or patrol, and in Scout Spirit as represented by living the Scout Oath and Law; and
- Whereas: Only about four percent of all boys in Scouting in the United States achieve the award of Eagle Scout each year; and
- Whereas: The Eagle Scout Award represents an understanding of Community, Nation and a willingness on the part of the wearer to serve both; and
- Whereas: The Eagle Scout Award stands for a job started by a boy when he first joined Scouting-a job started and finished; and
- Whereas: The Eagle Scout Award stands for strength of character, and is a symbol of what a boy has done. But more importantly, it represents what a boy will be in the future as he grows to manhood; and
- Whereas: Matthew D. Milligan chose as his project the installation of eleven (11) mile markers along the Summerlin Bike Path that stretches from Colonial Boulevard to Shell Point Boulevard. In an effort to help his community, he then planned, developed and organized the project solely by himself.
