RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION BY THE LEE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS REQUESTING AN EASEMENT FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVORONMENTAL PROTECTION FOR THE LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA MATLACHA ISLES DREDGING PROJECT

WHEREAS, Lee County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, is responsible for channel maintenance efforts in appropriate County waters, and

WHEREAS, Lee County Natural Resources staff have identified portions of the waterway leading into the Matlacha Isles subdivision and the City of Cape Coral as areas that currently do not provide adequate navigable depth in marked and recognized channels, and County staff members have designed a project which will remove approximately 1655 cubic yards of material from three areas in the waterway, and

WHEREAS, the primary purpose of the Project is to restore safe navigable depth to the one and only waterway access to the Matlacha Isles subdivision and a portion of the City of Cape Coral, and

WHEREAS, property owners in the project area as well as the public at large will receive a direct benefit from the completion of the project, and

WHEREAS, Lee County Board of County Commissioners approved an inter-local agreement with the City of Cape Coral for services to complete the project, on 8 January, 2002, and

WHEREAS, Lee County has submitted a Joint Dredge and Fill permit application to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection for completion of the Project, and

WHEREAS, The State of Florida has designated one of the proposed dredge areas as state-owned sovereign, submerged lands,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners, Lee County, Florida, that

- The Lee County Matlacha Isles dredging project will directly benefit citizens of Lee County and should be undertaken as soon as possible.
- 2. After securing the necessary permits, Lee County Natural Resources Staff shall work with the City of Cape Coral to complete the Project in a timely fashion.
- 3. The executed copy of this resolution shall serve as Lee County's formal request for easements necessary to complete the Matlacha Isles Dredging Project as proposed in Application No. 36-0173121-002, originally submitted to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection on the 25th day of February, 2002, and as amended by subsequent requests for information by the State of Florida.
