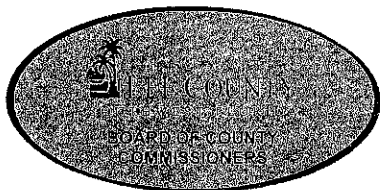
- Whereas:** Trees play a major role in sustaining life and beautifying this planet; and
