WHAT ACTION ACCOMPLISHES: Requests use of state property for access, construction, and maintenance of beach renourishment projects on Gasparilla Island and Lovers Key, including construction of a T-head groin in Gasparilla Island State Park.

7. <u>BACKGROUND</u>: Lee County has received state permits to complete beach renourishment projects on Gasparilla Island and Lovers Key, including areas owned by the State of Florida and managed as State Parks. In order to complete the projects, it will be necessary to use State Park property. In accordance with the Florida Administrative Code, the request for such use must be made by formal action of the BOCC.

State Park staff have already reviewed the proposed actions and provided comments. Upon receipt of this resolution, Bureau of State Lands will prepare the necessary instruments to allow the use of the park areas and define applicable conditions and terms. It is anticipated that a temporary use agreement will be granted for a five-year term of use for Lovers Key and Gasparilla Island State Parks. This will allow for access, staging, construction, and permit required maintenance of the beach fill. In addition, we expect to be given a fifty year easement for a portion of Gasparilla Island State Park for construction and maintenance of a T-head groin designed to restore and protect a sandy beach in the park area. The draft agreements will be submitted to the County for review and approval prior to final execution by the Governor and Cabinet sitting as the Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund.

The referenced beach projects are in the public interest. Authorization has already been granted for use of state owned submerged lands. Use of the uplands is necessary for construction access and to maintain the integrity of the project design.
