After many years of unrelenting struggles, we continue to affirm our commitment to the true American Dream - an integrated society rich in diversity

and open equality to all people

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE Board of County Commissioners of Lee County, Florida does hereby commend the NAACP for their commitment to

eliminate racial prejudice in our Nation.
