INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN LEE COUNTY AND THE CITY OF FORT MYERS FOR THE DONATION, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF CLEMENTE PARK AND RECREATION FACILITIES

This Interlocal Agr	eement for the donation of real property is made and entered into this
day of	, 2002, by and between Lee County, a political subdivision of the State
of Florida, acting b	y and through its Board of County Commissioners, "COUNTY" and the City
of Fort Myers, a m	unicipal corporation of the State of Florida, "CITY" acting by and through its
City Council.	

WITNESSETH

- 1. WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is the governing body in and for Lee County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida; and
- 2. WHEREAS, the Board of county Commissioners has certain powers and authority relative to the disposition of real property belonging to the County; and
- 3. WHEREAS, pursuant to section 125.38 Florida Statutes, the County has the authority to convey property by private sale to any government, or not-for-profit corporation or organization for nominal consideration if certain findings are made by the Board of County Commissioners; and
- 4. WHEREAS, the County owns Clemente Park, located at 1936 Henderson Avenue, Fort Myers, Florida (excluding the Williams Academy Building located thereon which is owned by the Lee County Black History Society, Inc.) Strap No. 18-44-25-P3-03000-0060; and
- 5. WHEREAS, the City of Fort Myers has adopted a resolution requesting the conveyance, for nominal consideration, of Clemente Park from the County so that the property may be used for public purposes; and
- 6. WHEREAS, the Board has carefully reviewed the property and finds that the property is not needed for any County purpose. And further finds that the use by the City of Fort Myers serves a public purpose and is in the public's interest; and
- 7. WHEREAS, the Board also finds that it serves a public purpose to convey the subject property to the City of Fort Myers for the nominal consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00).

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, and of the mutual covenants and conditions hereinafter set forth, the County and the City of Fort Myers, intending to be legally bound, hereby agree as follows:

- 1. County hereby agrees to donate and City hereby agrees to accept, subject to the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth, the 4.90 +/- park, known as Clemente Park, "PARK" (excluding the Williams Academy Building), located at 1936 Henderson Avenue, Fort Myers. Upon transfer of title, the City will assume full financial responsibility for the operation and maintenance of the park.
- 2. The Park consists of approximately 4.9 acres, 2 concrete buildings, 2 concrete walled racquetball or handball courts, 1 tennis court, 1 basketball court (with lighting and benches), one swing set, 6 concrete picnic tables, 2 BBQ grills, paved parking area of approximately 35 vehicles, 475 feet of concrete walkways and 2800 linear feet of chain link fence.
- 3. The County will donate, along with the conveyance of title to the real property, all surplus property and a one-time gift of \$50,000 to be used for maintenance repairs to the facility or to the property identified in #2 above.
- 4. The City acknowledges that the Williams Academy Building, a wood frame structure, is owned by the Black History Society ("Society") and that the Society leases the land within Clemente Park. [A Black History Museum and Archives is housed in the Williams Academy Building.] The City will enter into an agreement with the Society.
- 5. The City, seeking to preserve the historic character of the property, agrees to enter into an agreement with the Society and to continue leasing the land to the Society for as long as the Society shall need it.
- 6. The City agrees that the Park shall automatically revert back to the County in the event that the City should discontinue use of the property for purposes of a public park or fail to preserve the cultural significance and contribution of the Williams Academy Building, unless the discontinuous use of the park is caused by act of God or by strikes or other causes beyond the control of the City or the Society abandons the Williams Academy Building.
- 7. No assignment, delegation, transfer or novation of this Agreement or part hereof, shall be made, unless approved by the City and County.

This grant conveys only the interest of the County and its Board of County Commissioners in the property herein described, and shall not be deemed to warrant the title or to represent any state of facts concerning the same. RECITATIONS

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is the governing body in and for Lee County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has certain powers and authority relative to the disposition of property belonging to the County; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 125.38, Florida Statutes, the County has the authority to convey property by private sale to any government, or not-for-profit corporation or organization for nominal consideration if certain findings are made by the Board of County Commissioners; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Myers is a government which is organized for the purposes of insuring the community's interests and welfare as contemplated by Section 125.38, Florida Statutes; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Myers entered into an Interlocal Agreement with Lee County for the transfer of Clemente Park, (Exhibit "A", hereto); and,

WHEREAS, the Board has carefully reviewed the property and finds that the property is not needed for any County purpose, and further finds that the use by the City of Fort Myers serves a public purpose and is in the public's interest; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners also finds that it serves a

public purpose to convey the subject property to the City of Fort Myers for the nominal consideration of Ten Dollars (\$10.00).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that:

- The above recitations are true and accurate and are hereby adopted and incorporated herein as if set out at length, and said property is officially declared surplus.
- Lee County recognizes and accepts the City of Fort Myers request to receive the subject Lee County property (Exhibit "A").
- Lee County recognizes and accepts the City's proposal to use the County surplus property for recreational purposes. The City has made application to the Florida Community Trust for funding to acquire property to expand the park.
- 4. In order that the proposed transaction is more efficiently consummated, the Board specifically authorizes and directs relevant County staff to develop and finalize any necessary documents for the contemplated transaction, and specifically authorizes the Chairman or Vice Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners to execute any and all necessary documents for the said transaction on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners.
- 5. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
