BACKGROUND: Letters of Interest were solicited on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners for professional engineering/architectural services for the Sanibel Bridge Toll Plaza Reconstruction and Cape Coral Bridge Toll Plaza Reconstruction. The deadline for receipt of Letters of Interest was July 30, 2002. Only one (1) Letter of Interest was received from The Louis Berger Group Inc., by the established deadline. Because only one submittal was received, Contracts Management re-advertiseed the project for a second time to try and solicit additional submittals. The project was re-advertised on August 2, 2002 with a new deadline date of August 19, 2002. Several phone calls were made by the Project Manager to various firms to personally invite them to submit a Letter of Interest. Both Letters of Interest were considered at the Competitive Negotiations Committee meeting held on August 26, 2002. With two attempts to satisfy statutory requirements for CCNA selection, staff felt comfortable that we would have enough justification to proceed with the interview process with just two firms. The Competitive Negotiations Committee consisted of the following staff members: Jim Lavender, Director of Public Works, as Chairman; Scott Gilbertson, Director DOT and Don DeBerry, DOT Project Manager. Based on the information submitted by the Consultants in their Letters of Interest, it was the consensus of the Committee to invite both firms for an interview/presentation.

The interview/presentations were scheduled for September 12, 2002. On the morning of September 12, 2002, Contracts Management received a letter from The Louis Berger Group registering a complaint about the Competitive Negotiations Process that had taken place. In that letter, The Louis Berger Group withdrew from their presentation to be given on the afternoon of September 12, 2002. Based on this letter it was the consensus of the Committee to also cancel the interview with URS Corporation.

A call was made to The Louis Berger Group to discuss their issues and to try and have them reconsider from withdrawing from the process. This attempt failed. A meeting was then called with the County Attorney's office to reexamine our options.

Based on the discussions of all involved staff members, it was the consensus of the Committee to recommend that the Board concur with the selection of the sole Consultant for CN-02-23 Sanibel Bridge Toll Plaza Reconstruction and Cape Coral Bridge Toll Plaza Reconstruction and authorize contract negotiations to commence with the sole consultant, URS Corporation based on the following:

- 271 notices were mailed from the Consultants list maintained by Contracts Management (both times)
- Two advertisements were placed in the Fort Myers News Press at separate times.
- Very little interest showed at both deadlines.
- Numerous calls were made by the Project Manager to other prospective consultants.
- A re-advertisement will not guarantee any additional submittals
- Past history with URS Corporation is good.

Based on the Florida Consultant's Competitive Negotiations Act, The Louis Berger Group submitted the only Qualified Proposal in a timely manner, requiring that the existing Toll Equipment Systems Integrator, Transcore, be involved in the relocation of all Toll Collection Equipment from existing facilities to the new Facilities with 100% Toll Collections, as specifically addressed in our Proposal dated June 30, 2002. This understanding of the County's requirements was the direct result of four separate meetings between our Project Manager and County Staff.

We were advised that, while our proposal was the only acceptable one submitted within the guidelines of the procurement, the County was going to ask others to submit proposals, but, since we had already submitted one, we did not have to resubmit.

With your invitation to an interview on September 12, 2002, you added the requirement that Transcore be part of the consultant team. Transcore have indicated to us that they will be part of the winning team and have opted to join the URS team, and declined to join us.

Since there was no action taken on our submittal by . County, and since URS have been invited to submit a proposal, and since Transcore have apparently been advised that URS have been recommended for this contract in advance of the interview, we do not feel that there is any reason for us to attend the interview.

As this is clearly a flawed procurement, we would like to be reimbursed for our expenses incurred to date on this effort. We will be submitting an invoice to you under separate cover.

We are in receipt of your letter dated September 10, 2002, in reference to the above subject project. We are advising as follows:

In response to paragraphs 1 and 2, in accordance with Florida State Statutes 287.055, "Consultants' Competitive Negotiation Act," Lee County is required to select no fewer than three firms. As you already know we received only one submittal on June 30, 2002, and that was from your firm. In order to meet the statute requirements, Lee County opted to re-advertise and to solicit additional submittals. This second advertisement lead to one additional submittal, and that was URS Corporation. With two attempts to satisfy the statutes Lee County felt comfortable that we would have enough justification to proceed with the interview process with just the two firms.

In paragraph 3 you imply that Lee County added the requirement that Transcore be part of the consultant team. This is simply a misunderstanding on your part. I refer you to the Guidelines for Consultants, page 4 of 4, question number 2, "Have you worked with Transcore? Reference please." This question only asks if you have worked with Transcore, and if so, please submit any reference. Nowhere in this question or any of the other questions does it say or even imply that Transcore must be part of the consultant's team.

You have also indicated that Transcore relayed to you that they will be part of the winning team, and have opted to join the URS team, and declined to join The Louis Berger Group. Lee County made no pre-selection nor recommended any particular firm. Somehow you were misinformed from parties other than County representatives.

Our procurement process was not flawed during this solicitation. I assure you that this process has followed every step required by the Lee County Contract Manual as well as Florida State Statutes. I am disappointed to hear that your firm has withdrawn from the process.

I hope this letter has addressed your concerns. We look forward to receiving future qualification statements from The Louis Berger Group. If you should have any questions, or would like to discuss the matter further, please contact my office at your convenience.
