The Consultant has since completed all of the Phase I Tasks, including the following: development of the project management plan, review of past studies and evaluations of the WTP, additional bench scale testing, pilot scale testing, analysis of alternative treatment water supplies, and preparation of the Basis of Design Report (BODR). Phase I has been completed for the contracted amount of \$198,956.00.

Future Phase II Tasks have not been negotiated nor authorized by Lee County. Phase II Tasks were to include the following: final development of the 30% design plans, followed by 60%, 90% and final design, permitting, and limited construction engineering & inspection services. Future Phase II services were to be provided under Change Order to this Agreement.

The capital costs to improve the facility while gaining some additional treatment capacity have been estimated by the Consultant to be between \$11 million and \$20 million to gain between 1.3 MGD (million gallons per day) and 5 MGD additional treatment capacity, respectively. However, the capital improvement budget for this project is approximately \$9.3 million.

In reviewing the Basis of Design Report and these preliminary capital cost estimates in relation to the current project budget, Lee County Utilities has reconsidered action on the above referenced project, and is evaluating other options to complete the project improvements within budget while still gaining treatment capacity.

The Consultant has failed to meet its original goal for the facility improvements to be within the County budget and still gain additional treatment capacity. LCU staff will complete the final design of the project with savings estimated at approximately \$750,000 to \$1.0 million by taking this action. Therefore, Lee County Utilities is requesting authorization from the Board to terminate the Agreement with the Consultant at this time.
