7. BACK	GROUND:									
The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) currently owns a 47 acre parcel in North Fort Myers originally acquired as a spoils site for the construction of the Edison Bridge. FDOT has indicated a willingness to donate the parcel to Lee County. The property has approximately 2000 feet of frontage on the Caloosahatchee River and is bounded on the Northeast by Old Bridge Road. An Environmental Site Screen Process Inspection was performed in November 2001 and did not indicate any areas of concern. Recent site inspections by staff do not indicate any environmental concerns. According to the Lee County Property Appraiser's records, the current assessed value is \$545,700 and the property is wholly exempt from property taxes. The Department of Transportation, the Division of Natural Resources and the Division of Parks and Recreation have identified potential cooperative uses for the property and support acceptance of the donation by FDOT. Funding for improvements and maintenance will be pursued through appropriate capital improvement projects and grants, as indicated by final plans for use as determined by the cooperating departments and divisions. Necessary costs to close will be approximately \$100.00 Funds will be available in Account No. 20098330100.506199 Staff Recommends Board approve the Requested Motion. 8. 




