7. BACKGROUND: Lee County entered into an agreement with the Island School of Boca Grande on January 18,							
2000. The original agreement stated "Whereas such use of the Center is temporary in nature so as to provide the							
school with a facility while they actively seek to find a suitable permanent location". In addition the original							
agreement also stated: "PERMANENT SITE: In consideration of this Lease Agreement, the School agrees that it will start reviewing site selection for the permanent school within three (3) months of entering this lease							
agreement. The School agrees that it will acquire or obtain the property for the permanent site within two (2)							
years of execution of this Lease Agreement". The Island School has never offered a potential site, other than Lee							
County Property.							
On August 20th the Island School was asked by the BOCC to go back to the Community in an effort to reach							
consensus concerning the potential of building a School on the Community Center site.							
In December of 2002, the GICIA provided a poll of Island residents. 810 votes were cast in opposition and 633 citizens voted in favor of locating the school at the Community Center.
