1. REQUESTED MOTION

ACTION REQUESTED: Execute amendments to Contracts C-1818 and C-2016 between the Lee County Board of County Commissioners and Dunbar Industrial Action Development (DIAD):

- A. Contract C-1818 construction of 4 houses for low-income homebuyers (previously 2 very low and 2 low);
- B. Contract C-2016 construction of 2 houses for low-income homebuyers (previously 1 very low and 1 low).

<u>WHY ACTION IS NECESSARY</u>: These contract amendments are technical in nature and will allow Dunbar Industrial Action Development (DIAD) to complete its contractual obligations with the county.

<u>WHAT ACTION ACCOMPLISHES</u>: Allows the County to amend the grant award agreements with the grant recipient (DIAD) who will use the money for construction of affordable housing.

7. BACKGROUND:

DIAD (Dunbar Industrial Action Development) is a non-profit organization dedicated to providing affordable housing in Southwest Florida. During 1999, the Lee County Affordable Housing Committee recommended and the Board of County Commissioners approved (Nov 16, 1999) awarding DIAD a total of \$300,000 in SHIP funds over a three-year period for the construction of 12 affordable housing units. SHIP funds for 2 additional units were awarded in 2000/01 Supplemental Cycle #3 approved by the Board of County Commissioners on January 22,2002.

The total SHIP award for C-1818 (Year 3 of the three-year project) is \$100,000; and C-2016 (Supplemental Cycle #3) is for \$55,000. The terms of the awards are spelled out in grant award agreements that expire on May 30, 2003. DIAD has found that the number of low-income applicants is significantly greater than anticipated. These amendments will allow DIAD to better serve their low-income clients.

Staff recommends that these amendments be granted because: 1) they are in compliance with the SHIP rules and regulations and 2) it will ensure a timely completion of these projects and fulfillment of the terms of the grant award agreements.

No additional SHIP dollars are required above those already granted.
