Whereas: Each year, nearly six thousand children ages 14 and under are killed as a result of

unintentional injuries and more than 16 percent of all hospitalizations for unintentional

injuries among children result in permanent disability; and

Whereas: Lee County SAFE KIDS Coalition, a member of the National SAFE KIDS Campaign

network, led by Glenda Wolnik, R.N., Lee County Health Department, unites public, private, and voluntary organizations to reduce preventable childhood injuries in Lee County, Florida through community awareness activities, educational programs, and

public policy advocacy; and

Whereas: The National SAFE KIDS Campaign promotes childhood injury prevention by uniting

diverse groups into local and state coalitions, developing innovative educational tools and strategies, initiating public policy changes, promoting new technology, and raising

awareness about a range of risk areas; and

Whereas: Lee County Safe Kids, in partnership with Johnson & Johnson and the National SAFE

KIDS Campaign, will celebrate the substantial progress in reducing the number of childhood unintentional injuries by nearly forty percent over the past fifteen years

during National SAFE KIDS Week 2003; and
