CONTRACT SCHOOL DISTRICT OF LEE COUNTY DRIVERS EDUCATION PROGRAM ORDINANCE #02-28 DORI SLOSBERG DRIVER SAFETY EDUCATION ACT

This CONTRACT is made and entered into this	day of	_, 2003, between
the Board of County Commissioners of LEE COUNTY,	a political subdivision	of the STATE OF
FLORIDA hereinafter referred to as the "COUNTY",	and School Board	of Lee County,
hereinafter referred to as the "SCHOOL BOARD".		

The SCHOOL BOARD Agrees:

- 1. Offer a summer driver's education program at all nine (9) of its high schools.
- 2. Each of the School Boards high schools will be offering driver's education to 24 students for a four week, six hour per day program. The program is scheduled to begin on June 2, 2003 and end on June 27, 2003.

This delivery model will be sufficient for providing the required "in the classroom" instruction as well as the "on the road" instruction for 216 students. The program's objective is to have 100% of the students earn their driver's license.

The COUNTY Agrees:

- 1. The funds generated by the Dori Slosberg Driver Safety Education Act will allow the SCHOOL BOARD to begin to offer this program.
- 2. Allow for the release of \$41,428.00 from the funds collected through Lee County Ordinance #02-28.
- 3. SCHOOL BOARD agrees to provide to the COUNTY a "final" report of all expenditures using this program funding.

PROGRAM BUDGET:

The budgetary needs for this program are:

- Salary/Benefits for 9 teachers for 20 days \$40,028.00 (based on actual hourly rate of the nine (9) teachers.
- Gas and maintenance for 9 cars for 20 days \$1,400.00

TOTAL PROPOSED BUDGET FOR THIS PROGRAM:

\$41,428.00

AUDITABLE RECORDS:

The SCHOOL BOARD shall maintain auditable records concerning the procurement adequate to account for all receipts and expenditures. These records shall be kept in accordance with generally accepted accounting methods, and Lee County reserves the right to determine the record-keeping method required in the event of non-conformity. These records shall be maintained for two years after completion of the project and shall be readily available to County personnel with reasonable notice, and to other persons in accordance with the Florida Public Disclosure Statutes.

Both Parties Agree:

If either party shall fail to perform, or shall breach any provision of this Contract the SCHOOL BOARD or the COUNTY may give no less than 30 days notice to terminate this Contract, or take such actions and pursue such remedies as provided by law. The prevailing party in any action for breach of this Contract shall be entitled to receive attorneys' fees and costs incurred in such legal action.

The funding for this Contract is dependent upon the funds collected pursuant to the Dori Slosberg Driver Safety Education Act, Lee County Ordinance #02-28.

Each party warrants and covenants to the other that the officers executing this Contract have the authority to do so.
