disease each year due to the delay in diagnosis; and

diagnosis and treatment of this disease; and

Whereas: Lee County supports eye pathology screening at birth and all well-

baby exams to ensure that everything is being done to detect ocular diseases in newborns, infants and toddlers. The examination only adds ten seconds of time to the regular exam and costs pennies—a small price to pay to ensure healthy vision for all of our children.
