BACKGROUND: The roads Stepping Stone Drive and Pittsburgh Boulevard were built in two separate phases by the Developer, D.O. #95-09294.00D, Plat Book 69, pages 18-22. Phase I was constructed and accepted for maintenance on January 4, 2000. Construction on the Phase II portion of Stepping Stone Drive and Pittsburgh Boulevard is now completed and a Certificate of Compliance has been issued for the project. County maintenance specifically is limited to the road right-of-way and right-ofway drainage. All drainage structures and easements outside the limits of the right-of-way will continue to be maintained privately. Items specifically excluded for maintenance are: pipes extending from road right-of-way to the lakes, woodenstreet and stop signs and any wooden posts and landscaping within road rights-of-way not specifically accepted for maintenance. DOT is not responsible for constructing sidewalks not in existence at the date of Board acceptance, nor is DOT responsible for decorative pavers. DOT has received Grading, Paving and Drainage Plans for the project. The County has received a two year maintenance bond warranting defects in materials and workmanship.
