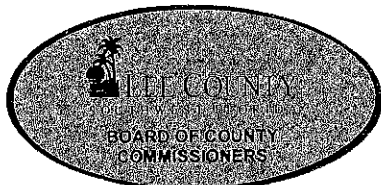
RESOLUTION
