Whereas: It is essential to plan and prepare for the accidental release of hazardous materials and to protect the well being of all citizens and visitors in the District; and

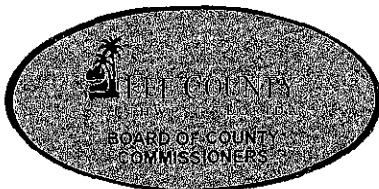
