The Contracts Management office received a request from Lee County Utilities to utilize piggybacking from the City of DelRay Beach, Bid #2002-37, for Sanitary Sewer Manhole Interior Rehabilitation – Annual Contract, with Chaz Equipment Co., Inc.

I am hereby requesting permission to piggyback on an annual contract with Chaz Equipment for the City of DelRay Beach. City Commission is requested to approve bid award to Chaz Equipment Inc. for an annual contract for Sanitary Sewer Manhole Interior Rehabilitation at an estimated annual cost of \$50,000.

Background:

Environmental Services is in need of an annual contract for sanitary sewer manhole interior rehabilitation for the purpose of eliminating infiltration and inflow, providing corrosion protection, repair of cracks and voids and restoration of the structural integrity of the manhole as a result of the application of monolithic fiber-reinforced structural/structurally enhanced pure calcium aluminate cementitious liner to the wall, ceiling and bench surfaces of concrete, brick or any other masonry construction material.

Bids were received from seven (7) vendors all in accordance with Purchasing Policies and Procedures. Bid #2002-37 on file in the Purchasing Office. A tabulation of bids is attached for your review.


