The Matlacha-Pine Island Fire Control District is planning to expand the Matlacha-Pine Island fire station, located at 5700 Pine Island Road. The facility requires additional area for expansion of the parking bays to sufficiently accommodate vehicles and equipment, including a County EMS vehicle. The land area required for the proposed station expansion is approximately 3,013 square feet and is a portion of Lee County's Phillips Park, located adjacent to the fire station. The Matlacha-Pine Island Fire Control District contacted the Parks and Recreation Department to request the land area required for the expansion of the facility. The Parks and Recreation Department does not object to the conveyance of the land area, as it serves the community interest and promotes the partnership that already exists between the Fire District and Lee County. RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, the Matlacha-Pine Island Fire Control District (District) has requested the donation of County-owned land in Section 28, Township 44 South, Range 22 East, Lee County, Florida (County) to allow the District to expand an existing fire station facility that currently serves the residents of Matlacha and Pine Island; and

WHEREAS, Lee County declares that the purpose of this Resolution is to convey 3,013.40 square feet or 0.0692 acres, more or less, of County-owned land to the Matlacha-Pine Island Fire Control District, a independent taxing district of the State of Florida, pursuant to a request by the said District in order to allow the District to expand the fire station facility serving the residents of Matlacha and Pine Island; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 125.38, F.S., the Board of County Commissioners has authority to convey County-owned property to the District without advertisement, compensation or consideration because the District is a non-profit organization created for the purpose of promoting community interest and welfare in the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, the property will be used for the sole purpose of a fire station and the District will not allow any other use for the said property; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has determined and is satisfied that the property is not needed for County purposes and that by virtue of conveyance to the District, the property will benefit the public or community interest and welfare and will be in public ownership.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:

The Board of County Commissioners authorizes the conveyance of the County's interest in the real property described in attached Exhibit "A" to the Matlacha-Pine Island Fire Control District, an independent taxing district of the State of Florida, without payment of any consideration therefore.

The Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners is authorized to execute the County Deed for and on behalf of Lee County for the conveyance of the County's interest in the real property described in attached Exhibit "A" and to do those things necessary to complete the conveyance of the real property interest to the District. The conveyance of the real property described in attached Exhibit "A" by Lee County to the District is subject to the condition that it must be used for the sole purpose of a fire station by the District, and should the District, its successors or assigns, attempt to transfer, convey, assign or use the property for any use other than the stated purpose, then the property will automatically revert to Lee County.



WITNESSETH: The County, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten and xx/100 Dollars (\$10.00) to it in hand paid by the Grantee, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained and sold to the Grantee, the following described real property, lying and being in Lee County, Florida:

In accordance with Florida Statutes s. 270.11, the County hereby reserves an undivided three-fourths interest in, and title in and to an undivided three-fourths interest in, all the phosphate, minerals, and metals that are or may be in, on, or under the subject land and an undivided one-half interest in all the petroleum that is or may be in, on, or under the subject land with the privilege to mine and develop each interest. Provided, however, the right of entry with respect to any interest in phosphate, minerals, metals or petroleum reserved in favor of the County is hereby released if the subject parcel being conveyed is or has always been a contiguous tract of less than 20 acres in the aggregate under the same ownership.

Said property is being conveyed pursuant to Chapter 125.38, Florida Statutes.

This herein described property is being conveyed to the Grantee subject to the condition of it being used for sole purpose of a fire station by the Grantee and should the Grantee, its successors or assigns, attempt to transfer, convey, assign or use the property for any use other than the stated purpose, then the property will automatically revert to the Grantor.

This grant conveys only the interest of the County and its Board of County Commissioners in the property herein described, and does not warrant the title or represent any state of facts concerning the title.


