WHY ACTION IS NECESSARY: To eliminate the confusion caused by the roadway's distance from the Koreshan State Historic Park.

BACKGROUND: In accordance with Lee County Ordinance, 88-13, the E 9-1-1 Telephone System Program Manager shall recommend approval for street name changes of existing plats within the unincorporated areas of Lee County. The Estero Community Planning Panel by a unanimous vote of support in a January 12, 2004, meeting, has requested that the name Koreshan Blvd be changed to Estero Pkwy. There would be no residential or commercial addresses to be affected by this change. The 911 Addressing Program received 100% approval of all interested landowners and property developers.
