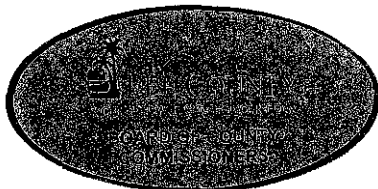
RESOLUTION

- Whereas: Ryan D. Jess, became a Boy Scout and advanced to the rank of Tenderfoot in the State of Montana in 1997 and achieved the ranks of Second Class, First Class and Star in South Carolina, advanced to Star and Life Scout in Georgia; and
- Whereas: In December, 2003, Ryan achieved the highest rank in Scouting, the Eagle while in Southwest Florida, Ft Myers, Troop 114. His project was a 6 month process as permits from the City of Sanibel and Florida Fish & Wildlife Conservation Commission were required to build a class II carnivore cage at the CROW (Care and Rehabilitation of Wildlife) facility located on Sanibel Island. Funds and volunteer time were donated by local citizens, The Ding Darling Wildlife Society, and a grant of \$3,000.00 from the Bailey Society of the Community Foundation of Sanibel & Captiva; and,
- Whereas: This cage, consisting of double entry doors, encased fencing in concrete and a separate overhead structure for protection from the weather, will be used to house and rehabilitate injured bobcats, alligators, crocodiles and other medium sized animals and amphibians; and,
- Whereas: The Eagle Scout represents accomplishments in Scouting Skills, in teamwork as a member and leader of this troop and in Scout Spirit as represented by living the Scout Oath and Laws; and,
- Whereas: Only about 4 percent of all young men in Scouting in the U.S. achieve the award of Eagle Scout each year; and,
- Whereas: The Eagle Scout Award represents and understanding of Community, Nation and a willingness on the part of the wearer to serve both; and,
- Whereas: The Eagle Scout Award stands for a job started by a boy when he first joined Scouting-a job started and finished. The Eagle Scout Award stands for strength of character and is a symbol of what a boy has done. But more importantly, it represents what a boy will be in the future as he grows to manhood; and,
- Whereas: Ryan D. Jess chose his project "A Cage for CROW" to help his community and the wildlife therein, and he then planned, developed and organized the project as a lasting tribute to wildlife.
