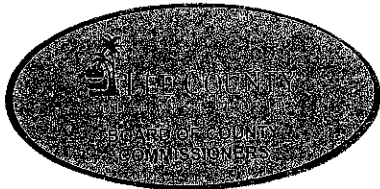
RESOLUTION
