JOINT RESOLUTION


- Whereas: The United States of America is engaged in combat against terrorism and tyranny around the world; and

- Whereas: It is proper for the Citizens of the United States of America, the State of Florida and the County of Lee to pay tribute to our fallen Heroes; and






in Lee County and urge all citizens to remember and honor this brave man who made the ultimate sacrifice in pursuit of freedom and peace for our country and the world.
