Any unit of local government failing to provide timely information required pursuant to the administration of this part shall, by such action, authorize the Department to utilize the best information available or, if no such information is available, to take any necessary action, including disqualification, either partial or entire, and shall further, by such action, waive any right to challenge the determination of the Department as to its share, if any, pursuant to the privilege or receiving shared revenues under this part."

Enclosed with the application is an information bulletin on the State Revenue Sharing Program. Your timely response and cooperation in this matter will be greatly appreciated and will expedite the distribution of your State Revenue Sharing Funds.
