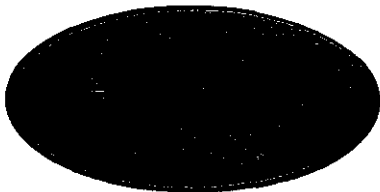
RESOLUTION
