WHY ACTION IS NECESSARY: Board approval is necessary to reconvey the County's rights in an unbuilt portion of a frontage road easement in accordance with §255.22, F.S.

WHAT ACTION ACCOMPLISHES: Releases to the requesting property owner any right, title or interest held by the County in an unbuilt portion of the frontage road easement at this location.

7. <u>BACKGROUND:</u> George M. Klein, Mary J. Klein, Eugene A. Pulice and Kathleen J. Pulice, the owners of property located at 15881 South Tamiami Trail, a/k/U.S. 41 (STRAP No.: 36-45-24-00-00011.0130), have requested the reconveyance of the County's interest in that portion of a 40-foot wide pedestrian and vehicular ingress and egress easement (an unbuilt frontage road) conveyed to Lee County by instrument dated April 6, 1990 and recorded in the Public Records of Lee County, Florida in Official Record Book 2148, Page 2383.

Florida Statute, §255.22, authorizes the County to reconvey property donated for a specific purpose if a request is received from an adjacent property owner and the County has not used the property for such purposes for a period of sixty (60) consecutive months. A review of the documents concerning this easement indicates the statutory requirements for reconveyance have been met. County Staff recommends the Board approve the requested reconveyance.

COUNTY DEED (Statutory)

THIS DEED, executed this _____ day of ______, 2004, by LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, whose address is Post Office Box 398, Fort Myers, Florida 33902-0398 (County), to GEORGE M. KLEIN and MARY J. KLEIN, husband and wife, as tenants by the entirety, as to an undivided 50% interest; <u>and</u> EUGENE A. PULICE and KATHLEEN J. PULICE, husband and wife, as tenants by the entirety, as to the remaining 50% interest, whose address is 15881 South Tamiami Trail, South Fort Myers, Florida 33908 (Grantee).

WITNESSETH: County, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars to it in hand paid by the Grantee, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained and sold to the Grantee and its assigns forever, the County's interest in a certain 40-foot wide easement for pedestrian and vehicular ingress and egress, being all and the same real property interest as conveyed to Lee County by George M. Klein, Mary J. Klein, Eugene A. Pulice and Kathleen J. Pulice, in the Access Road Easement Grant dated April 6, 1990, as recorded in the Official Records (O.R.) of the Public Records of Lee County, Florida, at O.R. Book 2148, Page 2383.

In accordance with Florida Statutes s. 270.11, the County hereby reserves an undivided threefourths interest in, and title in and to an undivided three-fourths interest in, all the phosphate, minerals, and metals that are or may be in, on, or under the subject land and an undivided one-half interest in all the petroleum that is or may be in, on, or under the subject land with the privilege to mine and develop each interest. Provided, however, the right of entry with respect to any interest in phosphate, minerals, metals or petroleum reserved in favor of the County is hereby released if the subject parcel being conveyed is or has always been a contiguous tract of less than 20 acres in the aggregate under the same ownership.

This grant conveys only the interest of the County and its Board of County Commissioners in the property herein described, and does not warrant the title or represent any state of facts concerning the title.
