**RESOLUTION**

Whereas: 2004 was the first year the 11-year-old Little League teams competed in the State Tournament. With 420 Little League teams in the State of Florida, over 300 teams entered the Tournament; and

Whereas: After 50 years of Little League baseball in Lee County, The South Fort Myers 11-year-old All Stars joined the exclusive company of the 1978 Fort Myers 11 to 12-year old All-Stars, after capturing the second state crown in Lee County history, when they rallied for a heart-thumping, 9-8, extra inning win at the State Tournament in Shalimar; and

Whereas: South Fort Myers got an early advantage blasting a two-run home run in the bottom of the first inning and saw the margin expand to 4-0 before North Coral Springs rallied to score three runs in the third inning. However, just like in 2003, South Fort Myers saw its lead vanish as the other team scored 4 more runs in the fifth inning; and

Whereas: The South Fort Myers team just kept fighting and in the bottom of the sixth inning, facing a two run deficit, they ripped a second home run tying the score. Thwarted by a series of good defensive plays by North Coral Springs, their confidence remained high and in the bottom of the eighth inning, South Fort Myers finally broke through giving them the State Championship; and

Whereas: The South Fort Myers 11-year-old Little League All-Stars posted a perfect 13-0 season, they were 7-0 in District 9, 2-0 in Section 6 and 4-0 in the State Tournament.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE Board of County Commissioners of Lee County, Florida would like to take this opportunity to congratulate the South Fort Myers 11-year-old Little League All-Stars on winning the 2004 Florida Little League 11-Year-Old State Championship.
