7. BACKGROUND:

On August 7, 2001, The Board awarded the contract for RFP-01-03, DISASTER RECOVERY SERVICES, to Crowder/Gulf, a Joint Venture to serve as a County debris management contractor.

Approval is required for Change Order No. 2 under RFP-01-03, DISASTER RECOVERY SERVICES, Lee County Contract # 1848 with Crowder/Gulf Joint Venture to remove debris from trailer pad sites in the Pink Citrus Mobile Home Park at a cost of \$800 - \$1,000 per pad site. This work is necessary to remove the threat of public health due to large quantities of destroyed residences causing unsafe and unsanitary conditions. Removing the debris would also provide a secure pad for temporary or permanent housing sites that would allow resident farm workers to return to Pine Island for work in the tree farms providing horticulture to developments within Lee County. The work would be conducted in accordance with the emergency ordinance governing the removal of hurricane debris from public and private property by federal agencies during declared emergencies. Cost to conduct the work is not expected to exceed \$50,000.00. Reimbursement of eligible expenses by FEMA would be based on mitigation the threat to public health, and would require a hearing to determine eligibility.


