

# Memorandum of Understanding College Parkway and Riverwalk Boulevard/Waterford Circle Installation of a Traffic Signal March 15, 2004

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding is to state the mutual understandings between Lee County and the Parties (see Exhibit A) regarding the project to install a traffic signal at the intersection of College Parkway and Riverwalk Boulevard/Waterford Circle. As the need for a traffic signal at this location is justified by traffic generated by the developments accessing this intersection by two private roadways to the north and south, the funding responsibility for the design and construction lays solely with the private groups or interests in the adjacent developments. Lee County will not provide funding for either the design or the construction of a traffic signal. Lee County will be responsible for the perpetual operation and maintenance of the traffic signal once it is constructed.

It is mutually understood that Lee County Department of Transportation (LeeDOT) through its Traffic Section will install the traffic signal designed by David Plummer & Associates for the intersection of College Parkway and Riverwalk Boulevard/Waterford Circle. The Parties, referenced in the attached Exhibit A, will provide the necessary funds to fully compensate LeeDOT for the material, equipment, and labor for construction of the signal.

Furthermore, it is understood that:

- The LeeDOT estimates the cost of the Project to be One Hundred Seventeen Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$117,300) for the labor, equipment, hardware and materials necessary to complete the Project.
- The Parties in Exhibit A agree to pay the LeeDOT the full amount of the estimate prior to the start of construction.
- The LeeDOT, at its sole discretion, will determine when, after completion of the Project, to activate the traffic signal. At no time will the traffic signal be activated sooner than completion.
- The LeeDOT agrees to provide inspection and administrative services to determine completion of the Project.
- Upon completion of the Project, it is agreed and understood that the traffic signal facility will be owned and its operation controlled by LeeDOT.

If this correctly represents our mutual understanding, please return the signed original with the attached Exhibit A to our offices.
