7. BACKGROUND

Letters of Interest were solicited on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners for professional services for Colonial Blvd. – I-75 to SR 82 Six Laning.

The deadline for receipt of Letters of Interest was September 21, 2004. A total of fifteen (15) Letters of Interest were submitted by the established deadline. All fifteen (15) Letters of Interest were considered at the Competitive Negotiations Committee meeting on September 27, 2004. The Competitive Negotiations Committee consisted of the following staff members: Jim Lavender, Public Works Director, Chairman; Scott Gilbertson, Director of Transportation, and Nicole Maxey, Project Manager, DOT. Based on the information submitted by the Consultants in their Letters of Interest, it was the consensus of the Committee to invite four (4) firms for written and oral presentations.

On the basis of the information submitted by the firms in their Letters of Interest and after conducting the oral presentations on October 7, 2004, with the "short list" firms, the Committee agreed to recommend to the Board the following order of ranking of Consultants: (1) WilsonMiller, (2) Barraco & Associates; (3) Kisinger Campo & Associates; (4) AIM Engineering.

The negotiated bid will be brought back to the Board for approval.
