NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on <u>Tuesday</u>, the <u>26th</u> day of <u>October</u>, 20<u>04</u>, at <u>5:00</u> o'clock p.m., in the County Commissioners' Meeting Room, Old Lee County Courthouse, 2120 Main Street, Fort Myers, Florida, the Board of County Commissioners of Lee County, Florida, will consider the enactment of a County Ordinance pursuant to Article VIII, Section 1, of the Florida Constitution and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes. The title of the proposed County Ordinance is as follows:

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE PROCEDURES FOR THE CHARGING AND COLLECTING OF FEES BY THE DISTRICT 21 MEDICAL EXAMINER FOR PROVIDING EXAMINATIONS AND INVESTIGATIONS RELATING TO CREMATION, DISSECTION, AND BURIAL AT SEA; PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A SCHEDULE OF FEES BY RESOLUTION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

 - 3. Anyone wishing to appeal the decision(s) made by the Board with respect to any

matter considered at this meeting, will need a record of the proceedings for such appeal, and may

need a verbatim record, to include all testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.

4. The Ordinance will take effect upon its filing with the Office of the Secretary of the

Florida Department of State, or as may be otherwise prescribed in the Ordinance.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE PROCEDURES FOR THE CHARGING AND COLLECTING OF FEES BY THE DISTRICT 21 MEDICAL EXAMINER FOR PROVIDING EXAMINATIONS AND INVESTIGATIONS RELATING TO CREMATION, DISSECTION, AND BURIAL AT SEA; PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A SCHEDULE OF FEES BY RESOLUTION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 406.11(1)(c), Fla. Stat., requires the District 21 Medical Examiner determine the cause of death for the District by such examinations, investigations, and autopsies as deemed necessary or as shall be requested by the State Attorney when a body is to be cremated, dissected, or buried at sea; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Lee County, Florida, approved a contract with the District 21 Medical Examiner which identified the collection of a cremation fee for each cremation certificate issued by the Medical Examiner; and,

WHEREAS, these fees will be used to offset expenses of the Medical Examiner in Lee County; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Lee County approved a budget strategy to reduce the cost of the Medical Examiner by the revenues generated by cremation fees; and,

WHEREAS, Chapter 125, Fla. Stat., authorizes the Board of County Commissioners of Lee County, Florida, to adopt Ordinances and Resolutions necessary for the exercise of its S:\GS\ORDINANCE\Lee COUNTY CREMATION FEE ORDINANCE\wpd

powers.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT THIS ORDINANCE IS ENTITLED, LEE COUNTY CREMATION FEE ORDINANCE.

Section One: Setting of Fee

The cremation authorization fee is established at Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) for each cremation approval issued by the Medical Examiner's Office for Lee County.

Section Two: Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

Section Three: Conflicts

Whenever the requirements or provisions of this Ordinance are in conflict with the requirements or provisions of any other lawfully adopted Ordinance or Statute, the most restrictive shall apply.

Section Four: Effective Date

This Ordinance will become effective November 1, 2004.
