BACKGROUND: In order to continue the recovery and mitigation process for the Lee County Bridgeless Barrier Islands, the extension of the Declaration of Lee County as a Major Disaster Area is necessary for the removal of "white goods" and C&D materials from the Barrier Islands through marinas on Pine Island until March 4, 2005. A waiver and the abatement of enforcement of certain Lee County LDC Regulations with respect to the off-loading of the "white goods" and C&D materials is necessary for the expeditious removal of the materials during the term of the proposed Resolution. The public's health and safety will remain at risk on the Barrier Islands until such time as the "white goods" and C&D materials from Hurricane Charley are removed and properly disposed of at authorized facilities in the County for such disposal. 8.
