7. BACKGROUND:				
The Florida EMS Grant Trust Fund is supported from traffic violation fines. Of the money collected in Lee County, 45% is returned to the County annually through the EMS County Award Grant Program. Lee County received \$175,171.28 in FY '04 and the Board approved on April 27, 2004, to accept the funds. Note, \$113,309.31 of FY'03 grant funds were rolled over in FY'04 and added to the grant funds received. Total grant dollars available: \$288,480.59. EMS met with the other Advanced Life Support (ALS) providers in Lee County to determine what countywide project would best serve the providers through the use of grant funds. The providers collectively agreed having a Medical Data Terminal (MDT) installed in their respective licensed ALS vehicles would assist in communication between the responding emergency vehicle and Lee County Emergency Dispatchers. Critical information needed for each emergency medical call such as location & address, type of emergency, caller name & phone number, mapping and driving directions plus any pertinent information associated with a call is provided. The need for voice communication is reduced, thereby mitigating the chance of verbal communication being misinterpreted. The installation of MDTs will standardize the communication information that is also being provided via MDTS to Lee County EMS ambulances. 29 MDTs have been ordered through Motorola for a total cost of \$209,844.00. INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN LEE COUNTY AND ESTERO FIRE RESCUE FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF THE MOTOROLA MEDICAL DATA TERMINALS

This Interlocal Agreement is made and entered into this _____ day of _______, 2004, by and between Estero Fire Rescue, an Independent Special Purpose Taxing District, as described in Chapter 2000-437, Laws of Florida, hereinafter, "EFR", and Lee County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, acting by and through its Board of County Commissioners, the governing body thereof, "COUNTY" and collectively, "the Parties" hereto.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, both the COUNTY and EFR are duly empowered pursuant to Florida Statutes, in particular Section 163.01, to enter into Interlocal Agreements for the sharing of certain governmental powers and obligations; and

WHEREAS, the PARTIES acknowledge that this cooperative joint exercise of power enables them to provide advanced services to the benefit of their jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the residents and property owners of the District and County to have this equipment at the disposal of EFR; and

WHEREAS, the Lee County Board of County Commissioners authorized Emergency Medical Service (EMS) to purchase and distribute computer hardware and software to Advanced Life Support (ALS) fire districts in Lee County; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the residents EFR and COUNTY to distribute this computer hardware and software to the ALS fire districts; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties agree to the following terms and conditions hereinafter set forth, EFR and the COUNTY, intending to be legally bound, hereby agree as follows:

- 1. The Recitals as set forth above are incorporated into the terms of this Agreement as if set out herein at length.
- 2. EFR represents to the COUNTY that the execution and delivery of this Interlocal Agreement has been duly authorized by all appropriate actions of the governing body of EFR; has been executed and delivered by an authorized officer of EFR; and constitutes a legal, valid, and binding obligation of EFR. The COUNTY represents to EFR that the execution and delivery of this Interlocal

Agreement has been duly authorized by all appropriate actions of the governing body of the COUNTY; has been executed and delivered by an authorized officer of the COUNTY, and constitutes a legal, valid, and binding obligation of the COUNTY.

- 3. This Interlocal Agreement shall commence on execution by the COUNTY.
- 4. The Motorola equipment purchased by the COUNTY will be placed in EFR ALS response vehicles (see Exhibit "A").
- 5. With a limited amount of bandwidth available on the Datatek System and the primary mission of the Premier Mobile Data Computers (PMDCs) is to improve emergency responses, the COUNTY'S Telecommunications Program Manager or his/her designee must approve any changes in PMDC or Advance Tactical Mapping Mobile (ATM-M) configuration or the addition of other programs that will increase the amount of data that utilizes the Datatek System.
- 6. EFR will appoint a person to act as PMDC System Administrator and liaison to the COUNTY'S Telecommunications Program. EFR will be responsible for training its personnel and installing its own updates to its PMDC laptops. The COUNTY'S Telecommunications Program's CAD System Administrator will provide technical support as needed, but only in regards to the PMDC and the Advance Tactical Mapping Mobile products.
- 7. While the COUNTY will purchase said equipment, EFR shall own and be responsible for, including maintenance, the equipment.
- 8. The Parties agree that by execution of this Interlocal Agreement, no party will be deemed to have waived its statutory defense of sovereign immunity or increased its limits of liability as provided for by Florida Statutes.
- 9. This Interlocal Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida.
- 10. No assignment, delegation, transfer or novation of this Interlocal Agreement or any part thereof shall be made, unless approved in writing by EFR and the COUNTY.
- 11. Nothing in this agreement should be construed to create any rights in third parties.
- 12. This Interlocal Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, EFR and the COUNTY have executed this Interlocal Agreement on the day, month and year first written above.
