Commissioner Coy spearheaded the organization of the Annual Veterans Day Parade and Festivities and the recent Memorial Services held by the Board of County Commissioner for Lee County Veterans killed in action; and
- Whereas: Commissioner Coy may be leaving his seat on the County Commission, but his life goal of education and community service will continue as he embarks on a new journey. He will be missed by his fellow Board members, but will now have the opportunity to spend more time with his wife, Lisa, and daughters, Aubrey and Chelsey.
