AMENDMENT No. 1 to USE AGREEMENT No. U-0310

This AMENDMENT TO USE AGREEMENT No. U-0310 is hereby made and entered into this _____, day of ______, 2004, between the BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE INTERNAL IMPROVEMENT TRUST FUND OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA, hereinafter referred to as "GRANTOR," and LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA , hereinafter referred to as the "GRANTEE."

WHITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the GRANTEE has embarked on a shore protection project (the "Project") Pin the vicinity of Lovers Key State Park ("Park") which is owned by the GRANTOR and managed by the Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Recreation and Parks under Lease No. 3340; and

WHEREAS, on April 24, 2003, the GRANTOR and the GRANTEE entered into Use Agreement Number U-0310 (the "Use Agreement"), which provides the GRANTEE certain controlled access to the park; and

WHEREAS, the GRANTOR and the GRANTEE desire to amend paragraph 28 of the Use Agreement to include some additional special conditions.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements contained herein, the GRANTOR and the GRANTEE agree as follows:

- 1. Paragraph 28 of the Use Agreement is amended to include the following special conditions:
 - (1) If the GRANTEE works in the Park after normal operating hours, the GRANTEE will be responsible for closing the front entrance gates after each individual entry and exit.
 - (2) The GRANTEE will protect the brick paver blocks from the weight of heavy trucks and equipment by using a minimum of ½" plywood and will be responsible for removing the plywood when not in use.
 - (3) The GRANTEE will make delivery of equipment only before or after peak visitation hours of the day, hereby designated as 10:00 AM to 3:00 PM. Deliveries during peak hours will only be allowed with specific prior approval of the Park Manager.
 - (4) The south beach area will be set aside as a staging area and considered a starting point for the Project in order to allow the Park's center beach access to remain open to the public. As the Project moves north and before it becomes necessary for the center access to be closed, the south beach area will be made safe and accessible to the public. It is understood that it may be required to close or

- restrict public use of all accesses for short durations during the Project for safety reasons. The Park Manager shall be required to approve such closings except in emergency situations. In emergency situations, the Park Manager will be notified of the closure and the area will be reopened as soon as practicable.
- (5) The GRANTEE may not hinder the use of the boat ramp by park visitors.
- (6) Storage of GRANTEE'S employee vehicles and necessary equipment will be allowed only in locations approved by the Park Manager.
- (7) The GRANTEE will construct, repair and maintain all structures it builds on the Park. The beach fill is not considered a structure.
- (8) The Park Manager will be responsible to identify and mark any dunes or other features that may not be disturbed by the GRANTEE. If the GRANTEE requests and is granted use of these areas by the Park Manager, GRANTEE will restore them to substantially the same condition existing before the construction.
- (9) The GRANTEE may use one of the Park's volunteer campsites to set up a temporary mobile office. Should the GRANTEE wish to have power and telephone services at this site, it will have to set up service for the utilities in its own name and be responsible for all costs and expenses associated with these utilities. The GRANTEE shall be allowed to install a septic connection to an existing Park system. All utility installations, locations, and connections shall be subject to the Park Manager's approval.
- (10) The GRANTEE will coordinate with and obtain approval of the Park Manager before undertaking any activity not specifically addressed herein.
- 2. It is understood and agreed by the GRANTOR and GRANTEE that in each and every respect the terms of this Use Agreement, except as amended above, shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect and the same are hereby ratified, approved and confirmed by the GRANTOR and the GRANTEE
