1. REQUESTED MOTION:

ACTION REQUESTED: 1. Consider acceptance of the recommendation from the Conservation Land Acquisition and Stewardship Advisory Committee (CLASAC) to allocate certain, 2020 funds into a separate, County interest-bearing subfund for the purpose of providing additional funding for the purchase of the Babcock Ranch property lying within Lee County. Should the purchase of the Babcock Ranch property not close, the funds would then be returned to the Conservation 2020 Program for continued land acquisition. 2. Create an interest-bearing, County subfund for Babcock Ranch, P.A. from the Conservation 2020 Program consisting of \$5 million from existing FY 03-04 Conservation 2020 funds, \$10 million from FY 04-05 Conservation 2020 revenues; and revenues representing up to .2 mills annually (not to exceed 40% of the total program revenues per year) starting in FY 05-06. Approve budget amendment resolution and budget transfer in the amount of \$15,000,000.

WHY ACTION IS NECESSARY: CLASAC recommendations were requested by the Board of County Commissioners. The Committee is proposing this action to assist with the acquisition of the Babcock property.

WHAT ACTION ACCOMPLISHES: Will allow Conservation 2020 funds to be used toward the purchase of the Lee County portion of the Babcock Ranch property. Establishes Babcock property acquisition subfund.

7. BACKGROUND: On November 4, 2004 at its regular meeting, the Conservation Land Acquisition and Stewardship Advisory Committee voted unanimously to support a recommendation to the Board that proposes an allocation of certain, identified Conservation 2020 funds be placed into a separate, County interest-bearing subfund for the purpose of providing additional funds for the purchase of the Lee County portion of the Babcock Ranch properties. The specific CLASAC recommendation was to allocate \$5 million in existing Conservation 2020 funds from Fiscal Year 2003-04; \$10 million from Fiscal Year 2004-05; and up to .2 mills, but not more than forty percent (40%) of the total program revenue per year, of the potential .5 mills allocated annually for the Conservation 2020 Program. The term of this transfer is intended to meet only the required funding for the Lee County portion of the Babcock property.



CLASAC consensus was to have interested parties obtain willing seller information for presentation to staff and to CLASAC after Nomination forms are obtained. Attached is a copy of Dr. Wilder's written presentation.

A copy of Ray Pavelka's hand written motion to contribute Conservation 20/20 Funds to the **Babcock Ranch** acquisition is attached. I have typed up his hand written notes as follows:

"In an effort to encourage and assist the Lee County Board of County Commissioners in the consideration of Lee County's participation in the acquisition of part or all of the Babcock Ranch, the Conservation Land Acquisition and Stewardship Advisory Committee recommends the following:

- 1. A reallocation of \$5,000,000 from the 2003-2004 Conservation 20/20 Acquisition Fund Balance;
- 2. An allocation of \$10,000,000 from the 2004-2005 Conservation 20/20 Acquisition Fund;

Both amounts to become seed money for a to be established or an existing acquisition fund at the descretion of the Board of County Commissioners;

3. An annual allocation of up to 0.2 mils, but not more than 40% of the tax base allocated for Conservation 20/20.

The proceeding motion is based upon the following:

- 1. CLASAC's support for significantly large parcels
- 2. CLASAC's support for acquisition of lands within Lee County
- 3. CLASAC not supportive fo making modifications to the 20/20 Ordinance to acquire a single property
- 4. CLASAC's interest in not over burdening the Lee County taxpayers should a bond referendum for the acquisition of the Babcock Ranch be initiated."
