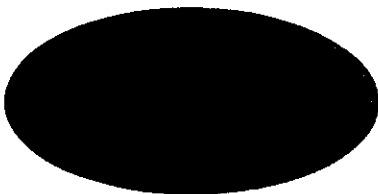
**RESOLUTION**
