7. <u>BACKGROUND</u> :					
On July 9, 2002, the Lee County Board of County Commissioners approved Agreement No. C-13112, Ten Mile Canal Filter Marsh, with the South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD). The agreement provided funds totaling \$450,000 for construction of the filter marsh with a 30-month term. Amendment No. 1 to the agreement was approved by the Board of County Commissioners at their regular meeting on May 6, 2003. Additional funding of \$150,000 was provided by the District through this amendment. The current agreement expired in January 2005. Amendment No. 2 extends the agreement until January 10, 2007 which allows for completion of the project. Exhibit D2 modifies funding allocations between several tasks with no change to the total agreement value of \$600,000. There are no funding implications attached to this action. Bid B-05-02, Ten Mile Canal Filter Marsh and Linear Park was awarded January 18, 2005. We anticipate construction to begin at the end of February.
