Lakes Park and Adjacent Waters Debris Removal

The City of Punta Gorda awarded Solicitation #Q04152, Canal Debris Cleanup, to Marine Contracting Group based on a schedule of unit prices. The contract was reviewed and approved by the Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) under an Emergency Watershed Protection agreement. Marine Contracting Group is currently providing canal cleanup for the City of Cape Coral through use of a piggyback to the City of Punta Gorda bid. Soon after work began in Cape Coral canals, the contractor requested a 7% increase to the price schedule to cover expenses related to transporting equipment and personnel from Punta Gorda. The Cape Coral City Council and NRCS approved the increase.

Staff from the Division of Natural Resources has met with the contractor regarding debris removal for the islands and waterbodies in and surrounding Lakes Park. The City of Punta Gorda has approved the use of piggyback of their Canal Debris Cleanup contract. Marine Contracting Group has agreed to use the rates currently charged to the City of Cape Coral (City of Punta Gorda rates plus 7%). The increased rates quoted are favorable to those we received on our awarded marine debris removal bid:

Our marine contractor has demobilized and returned to Miami Beach. Special Taxes/FrEIght

Your cost proposal shall include any freight, handling, delivery, surcharges or other incidental charges. The City of Punta Gorda is exempt from the payment of Federal and State taxes, including sales tax. Your cost proposal shall not include sales tax to be collected from the City. The City's sales tax exemption is not available to you for items you purchase, regardless of whether these items will be transferred to the City.

Delivery

Vendors must indicate a delivery date in their quote response. Delivery time may become a hasis for making an award. Failure to state delivery time may be used as a hasis for rejection of quotes. In the event deliveries are not made as specified to a City delivery point, the Purchasing Agent or Buyer shall reserve the right to purchase any quote item from the next lowest quoter. Repetitive failure to meet deliveries shall be just cause to cancel the contract in its entirety.

Use of Trade/Brand Names

When brand names, model, part numbers, and/or manufacturer's names are utilized in the context of the specifications, these are used only for description and are not a statement of preference. The item, product, or products, which differ from the brand name referenced, shall be considered if "the offered item or products meet the salient characteristics stated in the solicitation. Offers shall not be rejected because of differences which do not affect the suitability of the item or products for their intended use." Quoters are required to state exactly what they intend to furnish, and if varied from that specified, so indicate in spaces provided unless otherwise noted.

Appropriate brochures or catalogs are to be furnished and detailed information must be annotated where requested. Acceptance of any substitute item and/or commodity shall be the ultimate prerogative of the City. These specifications are not meant to describe any particular brand, rather to establish the minimum specifications and requirements of the City of Punta Gorda, Florida for which the item is purchased.

Substitutions

In the event the elected vendor, due to manufacturer or supplier discontinuing specified parts, is unable to secure sufficient supplies to fulfill all orders, the vendor will be allowed to substitute an item of equal or better quality provided: 1) The product is sold at the contract price; 2) The City is contacted in writing in advance of the substitution; or 3) The City retains the right to determine "equal or better quality". If the contractor is unable to fulfill all obligations in accordance with these terms and conditions, the City may

Quality Terms

The seller agrees to repair the product or to replace any malfunctioning parts, components, or assemblies at no charge to the buyer during this period. The right to reject nonconforming goods is retained for both latent and patent defects.

Material Safety Data Sheet, MSDS

In compliance with Chapter 442, Florida State Statues, manufacturers and distributors shall supply the City with a MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEET (MSDS) for any and all commodities contained in this formal quote that include a toxic substance as listed on the Florida Substance List. Elected vendor shall forward all MSDS's within 30 days of receipt of a valid purchase order to: City of Punta Gorda, Procurement Division, 326 W. Marion Avenue, Punta Gorda, Florida 33950.

Applicable Laws

Quaters are advised that all City contracts and/or documentation pertinent to this formal quote are subject in full or in part to all legal requirements provided for in applicable City Ordinances, State Statues, and Federal Regulations. Uniform Commercial Code, Chapters 671-679 et seq. Florida State Statues shall prevail as the basis for contractual obligations between in the elected vendor and the City for any terms and conditions not specifically stated within the context of this contract.

Public Record Law

Correspondence, materials, and documents receive pursuant to Formal Quotes become public records subject to the provisions of Chapter 119, Florida Statutes, subject to the right and prohibition to inspect thereunder.

Conflict of INterest

No employee of an agency acting in his official capacity as a purchasing agent, or public officer acting in his official capacity, shall either directly or indirectly purchase, rent, or lease any realty, goods, or services for his own agency from any business entity of which he or his spouse or child is an officer, partner, director, or proprietor or in which such officer or employee or his spouse or child or any combination of them, has a material interest. (Defined as direct or indirect ownership of more than 5 percent of the total assets on capital stock of any business entity). Reference Paragraph 112-313(3) and 112-312(12) Florida State Statutes.

Contract Agreements

The City and the elected vendor agree that this quote sets forth the entire agreement between the parties, and that there are no promises or understandings other than those stated herein. None of the previous terms and conditions contained in this contract may be added to, modified, superseded, or otherwise altered, except by written instrument executed in full concurrence by the parties

NO ASSIGNMENT OF CONTRACT

The vendor may not make any assignment of the contractual agreement between the parties, in whole or in part, without prior written authorization as may be given by the City, at its sole discretion.

No assignment by a party hereto of any rights under or interests in the contract documents will be binding on another party hereto without written consent of the party sought to be bound; and specifically but without limitation, moneys that may become due and moneys that are due may not be assigned without such consent.

Default

With reference to default, wherein the elected firm fails to perform to the contract's terms and conditions, written notification from the City stating the nature of non-conformance, which shall be remedied within a ten (10) calendar day period. If not corrected within the above time frame, the second notice shall be initiated stating that the City has taken additional procurement action in order to satisfy the balance of the contract. At this time, the firm shall be removed from the Vendor's List and shall not be eligible for award until the City has been reimbursed for all procurement costs to satisfy the base contract.

Concellation Clause

The City or the elected vendor has the right to terminate this contract and any subsequent contracts in full justifiable reasons, by submission of a letter of such intent, thirty (30) days in advance during the contract period.

Examination of Quote Documents

Before submitting a Quote, each Quoter must (a) examine the Quote documents thoroughly; (b) consider federal, state and local tax laws, ordinances, rules, and regulations that may in any manner affect cost, progress, performance, or provision, of the commodities and/or services; (c) study and carefully correlate Quoter's observations with the Quote Documents; and d) notify CITY'S Procurement Division of all conflicts, errors, and discrepancies in the Quote documents.

CHANGE ORDER TO CONTRACT

The following is a description of the Change Order Authority Levels for the City.

CITY REPRESENTATIVE OR CITY PROJECT MANAGER. If the City has named a City Representative or Project Manager in this bid this authority will be applicable. The City Representative or Project Manager has the authority to approve change order request in an amount up to \$750.00 and may approve requests for contract time extensions not to exceed five (5) days. Minor non-monetary changes, which do not result in a change in the contract amount, may also be approved by the City Representative or Project Manager.

PROCUREMENT MANAGER. The Procurement Manager may approve change orders in a singular or cumulative amount that does not exceed 10% of the total contract price with a maximum cap of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000), with the exception of contracts requiring City Council's sole approval for an award. The Procurement manager may authorize contract time extension in excess of five (5) days and non-monetary changes, which are not considered minor, which do not result in a change in the contract amount.
