

SECTION 1.00 CHANGE(S) TO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

The "Scope of Professional Services" as set forth in Exhibit "A" of the Professional Services Agreement, or Service Provider Agreement, referred to hereinbefore is hereby supplemented, changed or authorized, so that the CONSULTANT or SERVICE PROVIDER, shall provide and perform the following professional services, tasks, or work as a supplement to, change to, or authorized to, the scope of services previously agreed to and authorized:

#### I. Objective

The purpose of this task is to assist Lee County with surveying and environmental services associated with Florida Department of Transportation's Metro Parkway Extension Mitigation program in Six Mile Cypress Slough Preserve.

#### II. Basic Services

- 1. **Mitigation bid process assistance** Assist Lee County Parks and Recreation staff with the coordination of the mitigation bid process. This task will include assistance with bid documents, site visits and meetings with Lee County staff and potential contractors to answer questions pertaining to the mitigation program and facilitate compliance with U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and South Florida Water Management District permit conditions.
- 2. **Mitigation boundary surveying** Field locate the limits of the Metro Parkway Extension mitigation area and stake and/or flag the mitigation area boundary in the field. This task entails delineating in the field approximately four (4) miles of the mitigation boundary using sub-meter GPS technology. The boundary will be marked in the field using either wooden lathe or flagging tied to trees. In addition to the required field work, this task includes office research required to obtain digital coordinates for previous mitigation areas, the Six Mile Cypress berm extension project, and the original Six Mile Cypress Slough boundary that are to be excluded from this mitigation program.
- 3. **Mechanical harvesting delineation** Field delineate (flag), where necessary, the limits of exotic vegetation mechanical harvesting versus hand harvesting.
- 4. **Digital piezometer installation & data collection** Install three (3) digital piezometers at the locations depicted in the agency permit drawings to record daily water levels within the mitigation area. This task includes going onsite twice each year to collect the data from the three (3) piezometers for the required 5-year wetland monitoring period.

- 5. Construction, Engineering and Inspection - This task includes assisting Lee County Parks and Recreation staff with visits to the site and observation of mitigation activities during construction to facilitate compliance with regulatory agency permits. CONSULTANT shall make visits to the site at intervals appropriate to the various stages of construction as CONSULTANT deems necessary in order to observe as a design professional the general progress and quality of the various aspects of Contractor's work. Such visits and observations by CONSULTANT are not intended to be exhaustive or to extend to every aspect of the work in progress, or to involve detailed inspections of the work beyond the responsibilities specifically assigned to CONSULTANT in this Agreement and the Contract Documents. Based on information obtained during such visits and such observations, CONSULTANT shall determine in general if such work is proceeding in accordance with the Metro Parkway Extension mitigation plan and CONSULTANT shall keep Lee County informed of the progress of such work. CONSULTANT shall not, during such visits or as a result of such observations of Contractor's work in progress, supervise, direct or have control over Contractor's work nor shall CONSULTANT have authority over or responsibility for the means, methods, techniques, sequences or procedures of construction selected by Contractor, for safety precautions and programs incident to the work of Contractor or for any failure of Contractor to comply with laws, rules, regulations, ordinances, codes or orders applicable to Contractor's furnishing and performing the work. Accordingly, CONSULTANT neither guarantees the performance of any Contractor nor assumes responsibility for any Contractor's failure to furnish and perform its work in accordance with the Contract Documents.
- 6. **Mitigation monitoring** This task includes the field data collection, preparation and submittal of the seven (7) required mitigation monitoring reports to the regulatory agencies to document the progress of the mitigation activities. The monitoring program will consist of a Baseline Report, a Time Zero Report and five (5) annual reports that will be submitted to SFWMD and U.S. Army Corps of Engineers staff. Coordination and site visits with agency staff to conduct the final site inspection necessary for agency signoff of the mitigation areas is also included in this task.
- 7. **Project management** This task includes overseeing and coordinating with the various subproject managers responsible for implementing the various disciplines listed in tasks 1 through 6, onsite meetings with Lee County Parks and Recreation staff as needed, preparing monthly work in progress invoices, and other miscellaneous administrative services.
