9. Background: On September 7, 2004, the Board of County Commissioners approved Project Agreement No. 65-4209-4-1630 with the United States Department of Agriculture, Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) for vegetative and construction debris removal resulting from Hurricane Charley in the amount of \$499,840. On December 14, 2004, the Board of County Commissioners approved Amendment No. 1 to the agreement with increased the contract amount to \$3,380,000 and extended the contract completion date to May 1, 2005.

To date, we have successfully cleaned 48.7 miles of canals primarily in Pine Island through marine based efforts. Land based efforts have cleaned approximately 18 miles of creeks, canals, and ditches including: Pine Island Cove, Blue Crab Key Ditch, Antiqua Way Ditch, Charlotte Shores Canal, Birdsong Ditch, Johnson's Creek, Pelican Inlet Aqua Farms, Blue Crab Key Lake, Trout Creek, Park Road IDD Canal, Harbourview Canal, Ione Drive Canal, Bum Bum Creek, Hancock Creek, Yellow Fever Creek, Palm Creek, Pine Creek Lane Ditch, Popash Creek, Estero River, and Daughtrey's Creek North. Projects currently in progress include: Phillip's Creek, Orange River, River Road Canals, East Mulloch Drainage District, Lakes Park. Proposed projects include: Ten Mile Canal/Terra Verde, Powell Creek, Daughtrey's Creek, Deep Lagoon IDD Canal, Evergreen Road Creek, Tropical Point Lane Ditch and Barron Way Ditch. Extending the contract ensures we have time to complete all work.

All other agreement provisions remain unchanged.
